AGE LIMITS	WAG - Senior Category: 16 years and older MAG - Senior Category: 18 years and older All gymnasts must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event.				
JUDGES AND JURIES	There will be two judges panels (1 MAG judges panel and 1 WAG judges panel). The LOC will ensure a sufficient number of FIG breveted judges. All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline.

ENTRY FEES	No Entry Fee will be applied for this event.				
ACCREDITATION	All members will receive all necessary documents upon arrival. In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts safeguarding plan.				
EVENT FORMAT	The competition proceeds in 3 rounds: The first round - <u>qualification</u>: 12 couples take part (mixed pair – 1 MAG gymnast + 1 WAG gymnast), every gymnast performs on two pieces of apparatus. The second round – <u>semi-finals</u>: 6 best-ranked couples pass to the second round. In case of a tie for 6 th place, all the couples for 6 th place will participate in the second round. The starting order of the couples will be according to the results of the first round: the couple on the 6 th place shall start. In the semi-finals the gymnasts perform on one piece of apparatus which must be different from first round. The results of the first round are not carried forward to the second round - start from zero. The third round - <u>finals</u>: 4 best ranked couples in the semi-finals pass to this final round. In case of a tie for 4 th place the couple with the better result in the qualification round will participate in the 3 rd round. If there is also a tie, the couple with the higher number of highest scores will participate in the 3 rd round. The starting order will be determined by drawing of lots. In the final the female and male gymnasts perform on any of the pieces of apparatus (they can repeat any of already used piece except apparatus from the second round). The results of the previous rounds are not carried forward to the 3 rd round - start from zero. The Grand Prix winner is the couple with the highest sum of scores in the third round.
