## **RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE**

---

**Juniors** maximum 5 gymnasts

**Seniors** maximum 5 gymnasts

## **COMPETITION FORMAT**

---

**Juniors** 5/4/3

A junior team consists of 3 - 5 gymnasts, of which 4 compete on each apparatus. The 3 best scores on each apparatus are added for the final result. The NF nominates the team for each apparatus.

**Seniors** 5/3/3

A senior team consists of 3 - 5 gymnasts of which 3 compete on each apparatus. The 3 scores on each apparatus are added for the final score. The NF nominates the team for each apparatus.

## **AGE**

---

**Juniors** 14 to 18 years (born in 1998, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2002)

**Seniors** minimum 18 years (born in 1998 or previous years).

Gymnasts have the right to participate if they reach the determined age during the year of the competition. It is only possible to participate in one category: either senior or junior.

## **DEFINITIVE REGISTRATIONS**

---

These registrations must be done via the FIG online inscription system (<https://www.fig-gym.com/database>) by using the login and password of your federation; the online inscription system is open until **February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2016**.

## **NOMINATIVE LIST OF THE GYMNASTS, THE JUDGES AND OF THE OFFICIALS**

---

These registrations must be done via the FIG online inscription system (<https://www.fig-gym.com/database>) by using the login and password of your federation; the online inscription system is open until **April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2016**.

## **FIG LICENCE**

---

All gymnasts must have a FIG licence which has to be presented upon accreditation.

## **ENTRY FEES**

---

**Euro 100.-** per gymnast.

## **REGULATIONS**

---

In general, the Championships will be organised according to the valid UEG regulations for the European Artistic Gymnastic Team championships.

## **WORK-PLAN**

---

The participating federations will receive the work-plan according to UEG-regulations.

## **JUDGES**

---

A Federation participating in two categories (seniors and juniors) must enter two judges; a Federation participating in one category (seniors or juniors) must enter one judge.

A Federation participating with an insufficient number of judges or without judge will have to pay a fine to the UEG.

All judges must be holders of the FIG licence for the current cycle.

## **PUBLICITY ON THE ATTIRE OF THE GYMNASTS**

---

Federations wishing to display advertising motifs on attires used in competition by gymnasts and/or coaches must notify the UEG Secretariat by completing the form "Publicity on competition attire". The form must be received at the UEG Secretariat by **April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2016**.
