FEDERATIONS INVITED

The Organizing Member Federation will invite all UEG Member Federations, provided that their financial obligations to the UEG and the FIG are fulfilled. The inscriptions have to be made by the National Federations.

All federations are entitled to participate with either a team composed of 3 to 5 gymnasts, or a maximum of 2 individual gymnasts.

The number of coaches cannot be higher than the number of gymnasts.

AGE LIMITS

The participants must be in possession of a valid FIG licence and have the following age in the year of the event:

WAG Juniors: 14 - 15 years WAG Seniors: min. 16 years

Gymnasts who have participated as a senior in World Championships, Continental Championships, World Cup competitions, Multi-sport Games, may not participate afterwards in junior competitions.

JUDGES AND JURIES

Each National Federation with a team or individual gymnasts for the senior **or** junior competitions has the obligation to nominate **one** judge. Each National Federation with teams or individual gymnasts for the senior **and** junior competition has the obligation to nominate **two** judges.

The federations having been drawn with a D2 / RF judge will be informed of the possibility of nominating another E judge. The judges have to fulfil the requirements of the TR/UEG.

A federation participating with an insufficient number of judges or without judge will have to pay a fine to the UEG as follows:

All judges must have a currently valid FIG brevet at the time of the event.

ACCREDITATION

The accreditation office will be located at the competition venue.

The UEG Accreditation Rules will be strictly applied, notably as far as the number of accreditations per federation is concerned. No further accreditations may be issued (for changes after the deadline of the online nominative registration, please see the "Request for Accreditation Changes" form, which will be enclosed to the Work Plan). Any additional person is considered as a spectator and must buy entry tickets. Accreditations will not be delivered unless all financial and insurance obligations have been fulfilled.

Each delegation will be taken to the accreditation desk upon arrival. The following items will be checked there:

- · The passports of gymnasts and judges
- · The licences of the gymnasts
- For medical persons, the proof of their professional competences (copy of diploma or professional card)
- Prove of insurance coverage of the delegation (except for gymnasts and judges)
- Prove of the fulfilment of all financial obligations to the LOC (accommodation, meals, airport transfer (if applicable))
- The correctness of national flag and anthem of the country, to be confirmed with the form "Confirmation of the national flag and anthem"
- Floor music and "music release form", if not sent to LOC previously
- Departure confirmation

Floor music files format:

If possible wav, but mp3 and mp4 will also be accepted.

The name of each music file has to contain the following information:

- Country code
- LAST NAME and first name of the gymnast

By sending the music release form you

- confirm that the music used does not violate any copyrights and that it can be broadcasted within sports
- · confirm that your music files meet the technical criteria of the LOC

Please bring a CD of each floor music to the European Championships in case of technical problems and for the training sessions.

EVENT FORMAT

WAG competition Seniors (CI)

A senior team consists of 3-5 gymnasts, of which 3 compete on each apparatus. The 3 scores obtained are added and make the total result. The National Federation nominates the team for each apparatus.

It is possible to participate with individual gymnasts, if a National Federation does not have a sufficient number of gymnasts for a full team.

WAG competition Juniors (CI)

A junior team consists of 3-5 gymnasts, of which 4 compete on each apparatus. The 3 best scores on each apparatus are added for the final result. The National Federation nominates the team for each apparatus.

It is possible to participate with individual gymnasts, if a National Federation does not have a sufficient number of gymnasts for a full team.

WAG competition Juniors (CII)

The 24 gymnasts with the highest ranking obtained in the qualifying competition CI will qualify for the all-around final CII.

A maximum of 2 gymnasts per National Federation are allowed in the finals. For the all-around final, there will be 4 reserve gymnasts.

WAG competition Seniors and Juniors (CIII)

The 8 highest ranked gymnasts on each apparatus from CI will be qualified for the corresponding apparatus finals.

A maximum of 2 gymnasts per National Federation will be allowed in the finals. For the apparatus finals, there will be 3 reserve gymnasts per apparatus.

WAG competition Seniors (CIV)

The 8 best teams from CI will participate in the team final.

INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee, the UEG and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The UEG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage (except gymnasts and judges). The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the federations own charge as follows: CHF 185.00/person (flat-rate) for illness, medical fees and repatriation up to CHF 50'000.00
