<b>ENTRY FEES</b>	<b>No Entry Fee will be applied for this event.</b>				
<b>ACCREDITATION</b>	<b>All members will received the accreditation after arrival.</b>				
<b>COMPETITION FORMAT</b>	<p><b>The competition proceeds in 3 rounds:</b></p> <p><b>The first round - <u>qualification</u>: All the couples take part, every gymnast performs on two pieces of apparatus.</b></p> <p><b>The second round – <u>semi-finals</u>: 8 best-ranked couples</b> pass to the second round. In case of a tie for 8<sup>th</sup> place, all the couples for 8<sup>th</sup> place will participate in the second round. The starting order of the couples will be according to the results of the first round: the couple on the 8<sup>th</sup> place shall start. In the semi-finals the gymnasts perform on the 3<sup>rd</sup> piece of apparatus. The results of the first round are not carried forward to the second round - start from zero.</p> <p><b>The third round - <u>finals</u>: 4 best ranked couples in the semi-finals</b> pass to this final round. In case of a tie for 4<sup>th</sup> place the couple with the better result in the qualification round will participate in the 3<sup>rd</sup> round. If there is also a tie, the couple with the higher number of highest scores will participate in the 3<sup>rd</sup> round. The starting order will be determined by drawing of lots. In the final the female gymnasts perform on any of the pieces of apparatus (they can repeat any of already used piece) while the male gymnasts should perform on the 4<sup>th</sup> piece, different from the previous three. The results of the previous rounds are not carried forward to the 3<sup>rd</sup> round - start from zero. The Grand Prix winner is the couple with the highest sum of scores in the third round.</p>
