FEDERATIONS INVITED	The Organizing Member Federation will invite all FIG Member Federations in good standing according to the following principles:  Eligible to participate are National Teams and/ or Regional/ Club teams Juniors and/or Seniors, nominated by their FIG member federation.  Starting positions are limited to 18 teams for women and 18 teams for men. Therefore the organizers reserve the right to cancel the participation of teams due to limited starting positions.		

AGE LIMITS	MAG: Junior: born in 2001 - 2005		
	All gymnasts must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event.		
DELEGATIONS	Each international team		
	$\square$ has to accredit up to 2 coaches per team.		
	$\square$ must nominate at least 1 judge per team (1 for junior) possessing a valid FIG or National brevet, in the respective discipline.		
	$\square$ gets the opportunity to accredit one additional person (head of delegation, medical, driver).

MEDICAL SERVICES	Robert Kandelhart, M.D. (physician of the Austrian National ART Team) will be the official responsible doctor at the "TGW Austrian Team Open". Further Emergency transportation to the nearest hospital will be provided.		

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## **VISA** In case a visa is required to enter Austria, the Austrian Gymnastics Federation will be happy to assist each delegation with an official invitation (reference no.), provided that the request is made before December 14th, 2018 with the respective form. The request must include the full name, full home address, date of birth, place of birth, citizenship, passport number, passport expiry date and the arrival and departure dates of each delegation member. **INSURANCE** Insurance: The Host Federation, the organizers and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation. The Organizers will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Intl. Transportation: All participating teams must pay for the travel costs **INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION** of their delegation members to Linz. LOCAL The competition venue and the accommodation are easy to reach by car **TRANSPORTATION** or using public transport systems by buying a bus ticket (additionally you may reach the competition venue with a 10 minute walk from Linz's central train station). Organizers offer free transportation from/to Linz Airport and Linz central train station, if the Travel Form has been sent until February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 Teams arriving by plane at Vienna Airport (and do not connect by plane to Linz), should continue their journey by train. Linz is about 190km away from Vienna (1h50 by train directly from Vienna Airport). **ACCOMMODATION** The organizers offer two different types: IBIS Hotel Linz\*\*\*, Kärntner Straße 18-20. 4020 Linz (directly next to the central train station). Prices per person per night (including breakfast): Single EUR 95,-Double EUR **65,-**Prices per person per night (incl. halfboard\*): Single EUR 111,-Double EUR **81,-Youth Hostel Linz,** Stanglhofweg 3, 4020 Linz. Please note that the hostel offers only a few double and single rooms! Prices per person per night (including breakfast): Single EUR 70,-Double EUR **50,-**Bunkbed (3 or more) EUR 40,-Prices per person per night (incl. halfboard\*): Single EUR **85,-**Double EUR **65,-**Bunkbed (3 or more) EUR **55,-**\*) Halfboard includes Dinner on Friday, March 1st and Lunch instead of Dinner on Saturday, March 2<sup>nd</sup>.

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	Both accommodation options are located within a 10 minutes walking distance from the competition venue and are linked to it by a public bus line, which runs every few minutes. The bus tickets are not included and have to be bought by the delegation members at their own charge!	
	The prices charged for the hotel rooms will not exceed the usual hotel rates. While the Accommodation Form must be returned to the OC by <b>December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018</b> at the very latest, the Hotel rooms will be allocated on a "first come, first serve" basis.	
	The rooming list must be returned with the nominative registration on <b>February 1</b> <sup>st</sup> , <b>2019</b> .	
	The invited participating federations must pay for the accommodation expenses of their delegation members.	
MEALS	*) Halfboard includes Dinner on Friday, March $1^{\text{st}}$ and Lunch instead of Dinner on Saturday, March $2^{\text{nd}}$ .	
	On <b>Friday</b> , <b>1</b> <sup>st</sup> , <b>2019</b> and <b>Saturday 2</b> <sup>nd</sup> , <b>2019</b> organizers offer <b>extra lunch</b> in the <b>Youth Hostel</b> (if you are staying in IBIS hotel: It is directly connected to the Youth Hostel by a public bus line's 5 minutes ride).	
	The costs for the extra lunch are as follows:	
	EUR 15,- per person per lunch	
	The invited participating federations must pay for the lunch expenses of their delegation members.	
	The meals form for the extra lunch must be returned to the OC by <b>December, 14<sup>th</sup> 2018</b> at the very latest.	
	The costs for the meals must be paid to the OC by <b>February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019</b> .	
CANCELLATION POLICY	For any and all cancellations, partial or total, made between December $14^{\text{th}}$ 2018 and February $1^{\text{st}}$ 2019, a cancellation fee of 75% of the total accommodation costs has to be paid to the organizers. The entry fee is non-refundable.	
	For any and all cancellations, partial or total, made after February $1^{\rm st}$ 2019, a cancellation fee of 100% of the total costs has to be paid to the organizers.	
FAREWELL DINNER	After the competition the Organizers offer a farewell dinner for all delegation members at the cost of EUR 15,- per person.	
BANK ACCOUNT INFORMATION	The Austrian Gymnastics Federation will send out <b>invoices</b> for entry fee, accommodation, Extra lunches and Farewell Dinner following the definitive entry. These invoices <b>will have to be paid until February 1</b> <sup>st</sup> , 2019.
