4. SITE, PODIUM AND OBSTACLES

The podium has a dimension of 45 x 10 m. The obstacles are provided by Taishan. For the plan of the site see Appendix 1 A warm-up / stretching area is located next to the podium.

Arrivals

The LOC personnel will be present at Chengdu airport with greeting signs to welcome the delegations / athletes, provided the arrival time has been communicated. The picture of the greeting sign is as below:



Transportation is provided from the airport to the hotels for the invited athletes and those delegations (athletes) having booked their accommodation via the LOC.

Transportation between the hotel and the competition site will be provided by the LOC. The schedule for shuttle buses may be distributed at accreditation.

Departures

Transportation will be coordinated by the LOC from the official hotels to the airport based on the travel forms from the delegation / information of the athletes. The departure dates and time must be confirmed during the Orientation meeting.

6. ACCREDITATIONS

Access to the site is ruled by accreditation. Accreditations are handed out in the lobby of the official hotel upon arrival.

7. MEETINGS AND OTHER EVENTS

Orientation Meeting

The Orientation Meeting held in English will take place **4 April 2019 at 20:00 at the Hotel**.

Important and detailed information concerning the organisation of the World Cup competition will be provided by the LOC and the FIG.

Participation is compulsory all athletes or heads of delegation (for the athletes being part of the delegation) and judges.

Judges' Instructions, Briefings and Draw

All the judges are required to take part in this instruction and in all subsequent briefings. Judges who do not participate will not be authorised to judge.

The athletes' meeting will take place **5 April at 17:00 at the Hotel**. Athletes are invited to attend and to discuss with their representative.

12. COMPETITION

Competitions will be conducted in accordance with the 2019 FIG Technical Regulations including Section 7 for PK, the current PK COP and other technical directives of the FIG.

Speed Running Qualifications are run one after the other, finals by pairs, but without knock out system, only the time counts.

Athletes' drawing of lots

The drawing of lots will take place during the Orientation meeting, **5** April at **20:00** hours at the hotel.

Timing and Scoring

The scoring system is provided by SEIKO Time System. Details for scoring freestyle see Appendix 2 and 3. Details for timing see Appendix 4

13. ANNOUNCEMENTS DURING COMPETITIONS

During the competitions, the announcements will be made in Chinese and in English.

14. SCORING

The scoring system is provided by the Runnar company. Details see Appendix 6 A and 6B.

15. AWARD CEREMONIES

The awards ceremonies will be held immediately after each final. The athletes are requested to attend.

16. MEDICAL SERVICES

The medical service is provided by the Local Organizing Committee according to the FIG Rules "MEDICAL ORGANISATION OF THE FIG COMPETITIONS".

17. ANTI DOPING CONTROL AND THERAPEUTIC USE EXPEMPTIONS

Anti-doping control will be organized according to the valid WADA Code, Standards and FIG Anti-Doping Rules.

The anti-doping controls may take place at any time.

As per the applicable FIG Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) procedure in effect concerning the participation at FIG Events, any athlete in need of a TUE is responsible, together with his/her Federation, to submit his/her request to the FIG no later than 30 days before the start of this competition. No TUE request will be accepted nor approved on spot, except for duly justified emergency cases

18. PRIZE MONEY

The Prize Money will be transferred by account by the FIG at the end of the World Cup competition

The following Prize Money in CHF will be allocated for each category (speed running and freestyle, men and women:

Should less than 4 federations participate in the World Cup competition (Speed Running and/or Freestyle), no prize money will be paid.

19. MEDIA AND TV

Television

CCTV will guarantee television production of the competition. Competitors are requested to strictly follow the instructions of the Local Organising Committee.

Cameras and video recording

All runs will be recorded in high definition by digital video cameras.

In order to protect television rights, personal video or TV cameras and recording is prohibited. The only exceptions are the host broadcaster, and the 2 video cameras for judging purpose.

Photos may be taken.
