DELEGATION	Delegations exist of: 1 head of Delegation 1 Coach 1 Judge 4 gymnasts (age group 2001 and younger)
JUDGES AND JURIES	All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet 1/2/3 at the time of the event. Each federation taking part in the competition must bring a judge. The fine for a missing judge is 350,00 Euro.
GUIDELINES	The scoring will be carried out according to the Code of Points 2017 - 2020 for Juniors (current valid constitution).


COMPETITION FORMATS	<p>Team Competition: Team 4/4/3 (at least 1 gymnast has to belong to age group 1) All 4 gymnasts perform on all six apparatus. The three highest scores count for the final team result. Single gymnasts are not permitted.</p> <p>Apparatus Finals: The best 6 gymnasts will qualify for the Finals in the categories 1, 2, 3 (max. 1 per nation). A Wildcard is indicated for the hosting club. Qualifications on Vault: C.d.P. Juniors for age groups 1 and 2 and two different Vaults from one or different Vault Groups in age group 3</p>
MEDALS & REWARDS	<p>Participation's certificate for all gymnasts. Individual by age group: the best 3 gymnasts Team Competition: the best 3 teams Apparatus Finals: the best 3 gymnasts per category</p>

TRAVEL EXPENSES	<p>Each federation has to take over the travel expenses to Berlin by themselves. The organising committee will provide a shuttle service from/to the airport Tegel (TXL) or Schoenefeld (SXF) or alternatively to the train station on the official arrival and departure days. Earlier arrivals or later departures are at the expenses of the participants. No shuttle service can be guaranteed.</p>
ENTRY FEE	<p>The night in a single bed room costs 95,00€, the double-bed 75,00€ and the tripple-bed room 70,00€. Other fellow traveler pay 10,00€ extra apart from the room-price.</p> <p>For any additional nights and rates please contact the OC.</p>
STORNO CONDITIONS	<p>The registration can be cancelled until the 4th March 2019. From the 5th on the whole Amount must be paid</p>
SIGHTSEEING TOUR	<p>If you are interested in joining a sightseeing tour on Saturday morning, please register the latest until the technical meeting on Thursday night. The entry fee is 10,00 € p. p.</p>
FAREWELL-PARTY	<p>Gymnasts and accredited officials will receive a ticket for the farewell-party at the accreditation.</p>

The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before March 18th 2019 to the OC.</p> <p>The request has to include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city and address the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p>
