The "Austrian Alps Cup" is an international event; open to all clubs affiliated in the respective Federations as well as Representatives of National Federations, District or Regional Associations. All delegation members must have a valid health and accident insurance. The organizers will not be held responsible for any accidents.

Age Limits:

The "Austrian Alps Cup" is open for the age groups 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-21 and Senior with by gender separated competitions for each Age group. **All gymnasts must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event.**

Accreditation:

Accreditation will be on Friday, 1st of Nov. 2019 starting at 06:00 p.m. at the competition venue.

Event Format:

Valid FIG Trampoline Code of Points 2017-2020.

75% of all starters in each category – min. four (4), max eight (8) – will advance to the final.

In the finals the IOC tie-break rules for individual competition will be applied.

Medical Services:

Medical services (a doctor as well as emergency transportation to the nearest hospital) will be provided during the event.

Media:

Participants at the competition automatically agree to be photographed and filmed for live stream or press relations and declare their unreserved agreement to the publication, which is free of charge by the Austrian Gymnastics Federation and other cooperating partners and media.

Visa:

In case a visa is required to enter Austria the Austrian Gymnastics Federation will be happy to assist each delegation with an official invitation (reference no.), provided that the request is made before **20**th **August 2019** with the respective form. The request must include the <u>function</u>, <u>full name</u>, <u>gender</u>, <u>date of birth</u>, <u>place of birth</u>, <u>home address</u>, <u>citizenship and passport number</u>, <u>passport expiry date</u>, the <u>arrival and departure dates</u> of each delegation member.

Insurance:

The Host Federation, the organizers and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.

The Organizers will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy).

Difficulties:

Comp. 1/2: according to FIG 11-12 years rules for WAGC.

1. The routine consists of 10 different elements

- 2. only two (2) elements allowed with less than 270° somersault rotation. Each element meeting the requirement must be marked with an asterisk (*) on the competition card. These requirements cannot be fulfilled by combining them into one element but must be performed as separate elements.
- 3. 1 element landing on the back of the body
- 4. 1 element landing on the front of the body
- 5. back somersault with full twist

Comp. 3/4: according to FIG 13-14 years rules for WAGC.

- 1. The routine consists of 10 different elements
- 2. only one (1) element allowed with less than 270° somersault rotation. Each element meeting the requirement must be marked with an asterisk (*) on the competition card. These requirements cannot be fulfilled by combining them into one element but must be performed as separate elements.
- 3. one (1) element to the front or back
- 4. one (1) element from front or back- in combination with N°3
- 5. one (1) double front or back somersault with or without twist and
- 6. one (1) element with a minimum of 540° twist and minimum 360° sommers ault rotation

Comp. 5/6: according to FIG 15-16 years rules for WAGC.

- 1. The routine consists of 10 different elements
- 2. only one (1) element allowed with less than 270° somersault rotation. Each element meeting the requirement must be marked with an asterisk (*) on the competition card.



















These requirements cannot be fulfilled by combining them into one element but must be performed as separate elements.

- 3. one (1) element to the front or back
- 4. one (1) element from front or back- in combination with N°3
- 5. one (1) double front or back somersault with or without twist and
- 6. one (1) element with a minimum of 540° twist and minimum 360° sommers ault rotation

Comp. 7/8 according to FIG 17-21 years rules for WAGC.

- 1. The routine consists of 10 different elements each with a minimum of 270°sommersault rotation
- 2. two (2) elements, marked with an asterisk (*) on the competition card, will have difficulty ratings. The difficulty will be added to the execution, time of flight and horizontal displacement scores to give the total score for the first routine.
- 3. None of these two (2) elements may be repeated in the second routine of the qualifying round; otherwise the difficulty of these repeated elements will not be counted

Comp. 9/10: FIG A according to Code of Points

11-12 years: 1,5 pts. 13-14 years: 1,7 pts. 15-16 years: 1,8 pts. 17-21 years: 1,8 pts.

For 11-12 years old, triple somersaults are prohibited For all age groups, quadruple somersaults are prohibited
