All participating Federations commit to abide by the Statutes and all FIG Rules and Regulations. National Federations not respecting them will not be allowed to participate.

5. PARTICIPATION RIGHT AND ACCREDITATIONS

All NFs in good standing are entitled to participate with a full team of max. 8 athletes.

The size of delegation is as follows: (does not include athletes invited by FIG and approved by NF)

All athletes have the right to participate in both events.

For other delegation members, see FIG Accreditation rules.

6. AGE LIMIT OF ATHLETES

All participants must be minimum 17 years old in the year of the event (i.e. born in 2003 or earlier).

7. REGISTRATIONS

Registrations can only be made by FIG affiliated federations in good standing, via the <u>FIG</u> on-line system (click here) and by using the National Gymnastics Federations' login (e-mail) and password.

Definitive Registration

The definitive registrations must be completed by entering the composition of the delegation at the latest the 2 February 2020.

Nominative Registration

The nominative entries must be completed by entering the composition of the delegation at the latest the 2 March 2020.

Together with the nominative registration and to accelerate the process of the accreditation, the delegations must send one passport photo of each delegation member to ikoslacz@fig-gymnastics.org.

Requirements for each identity color photo:

- Identity: country code_event level_function_full name, for example: CHN_WAGC ACRO_Team Manager_LI Haoyang
- File format: .jpg or .jpeg
- Dimensions: min. 175 X 225 pixels, max. 1750 X 2250 pixels (width X height)
- File size: max. 2MB

Accreditations sent without photos will not be handled with priority. You may wait at the accreditation desk.

After the drawing of lots, no athlete can be added. No additional athlete may appear on the Nominative Registration and at accreditation.

Please consult FIG Technical Regulations for additional information in this respect.

8. LICENSES

The LOC will be responsible for checking the validity of the Athletes Licenses. No athletes will be accepted without a FIG License valid until the end of the competitions.

In order to be considered, Licence application forms (new or renewal) <u>must</u> be submitted <u>at least one (1) month prior to the deadline</u>.

Please consult FIG License Rules for additional information in this respect.

9. JUDGES AND JURY OF APPEAL

Judges

FIG will appoint five PK FIG Category 1 judges and pay their travel, plus room and board. For 2020 World Championships: only Category 1 judges from federations that participated in the 2019 World Cup Series or WUG may judge the freestyle competitions. All other judges will be drawn to positions for the Speed competitions.

The FIG Presidential Commission will appoint the Chair of Judges' Panel upon proposal of the PK Commission. The Chair of Judges' Panel, from the five Category 1 judges, will keep the same position for all phases of the competitions.

Judges are requested to arrive in Hiroshima one day before the Judges' Instruction at the very latest, and to be available until the last day of the competition.

Jury of Appeal and Supervisory Board

The Jury of Appeal consists of two members of the Executive Committee (one acting as President) and a third person to be designated in accordance with the matter of the appeal. In case of an

appeal, a person not involved in the decision of the Superior Jury or the judging process will be nominated.

The composition of the Jury of Appeal will be communicated in the Workplan.

10. DRAWING OF LOTS

The athletes drawing of lots will decide the starting order of the qualification competitions. It will take place during the orientation meeting.

11. COMPETITION FORMAT AND PROGRAMME

Competitions consist of Qualifications, Semi-Finals (Speed only) and Finals. The score from Qualification will not be carried forward. All runs, also the Finals, start from 0 points.

Speed

Speed competitions will be organized on two parallel lanes.

Speed Qualifications

The starting order for the first run of Qualification will be determined by a draw. An intermediate ranking list is established at the end of the first run.

The athletes may choose to have a second run. Should they choose a second run, they have to announce it immediately after the end of their course by raising their hand after seeing their time. The starting order for this second (optional) run is determined by the original starting order, but only with the athletes performing a second run.

For the athletes who have chosen to have a second run, the result of the second run only counts.

The final ranking list of the Qualification will be established at the end of the second run. In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules set out in art. 4.1 apply.

Runners' lanes- Lane 1 is farthest from the judge's tower and Lane 2 is closest, assigned by draw

Speed Semi-Finals

Knock-out competition format

The top athletes from the final ranking list of the Qualification (max. 2 per NF) participate in the Semi-Finals. No second run is possible.

In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules set out in art. 4.1 applies

The highest ranked athlete faces the lowest ranked athlete, and the loser of that race is excluded from advancing to the final. Another example, the athlete ranked 2nd faces the 2nd to last athlete from the Qualification and so on for each athlete to be matched against the appropriate competitor. The loser of each race is excluded from advancing to the final.

In case of a tie at the 6th rank for the Final, the tie-breaking rules set out in art. 4.1– apply.

Three reserve athletes will be able to warm-up for the Semi-Final and Final rounds.

Runners' lanes- Lane 1 is farthest from the judge's tower and Lane 2 is closest, determined by qualifying time

Speed Finals

The top 6 athletes from the final ranking list of the Qualification or the semi-finals (max. 2 per NF) participate in the Final.

In the final round, the 5th and 6th, the 3rd and 4th and the 1st and 2nd run by pairs. The final ranking is based on the time (no knock out).

In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules set out in art. 4.1 apply.

The Final is held in one single run.

Runners' lanes- Lane 1 is farthest from the judges' tower and Lane 2 is closest, determined by qualifying time

Freestyle

Freestyle Qualifications

The starting order for the first run of Qualification will be determined by a draw.

The runs of 30 to 70 seconds, are judged based on the criteria defined in the Code of Points.

An intermediate ranking list is established at the end of the first run.

The athletes may choose to have a second run. Should they choose a second run, they have to announce it immediately after the end of their course (before the score is shown) by raising their hand. The starting order for this second (optional) run is determined by the original starting order, but only with athletes performing a second run.

For the athletes who have chosen to have a second run, the result of the second run only counts.

The final ranking list of the Qualification will be established at the end of the second run.

In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules set out in art. 4.2 apply.

Freestyle Finals (max. 2 per NF)

The top eight athletes from the final ranking list of the Qualification participate in the Final.

In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules set out in art. 4.2 apply.

The Final is held in one single run.

The starting order is established based on the ranking after Qualification with the best athletes starting last.

All delegations can purchase tickets at the airport to the Hiroshima bus station (1370 yen). Someone from the LOC will be at the station to greet and guide the delegations.

No transportation will be available between the hotels and the competition site, as the host hotels are all within walking distance.



22.INSURANCE

The Host Federation (LOC) and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, and repatriation. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for <u>all the members</u> of their Delegation.

<u>Athletes/Judges</u> need to provide evidence of the health insurance, which covers adequately the costs for medical treatment following illness/accident occurred in their home/residence country and while returning from abroad with accident or illness requiring continued treatment. The FIG insurance will provide subsidiary coverage during max. 365 days.

<u>Each delegation</u> is requested to send to the LOC a copy of their insurance,. Delegation members with insufficient insurance coverage must inform the LOC in writing in advance via email or fax. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge.

23. WORK PLAN

The Work Plan will be published on the FIG online calendar six weeks at the latest before the start of the competitions.

25. DOPING CONTROLS

Under the supervision of the FIG, anti-doping controls will be organized according to the valid WADA Code, WADA International Standards and FIG Anti-Doping Rules.

The anti-doping controls may take place at any time.

As per the applicable FIG Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) procedure in effect concerning the participation at FIG Events, any gymnast in need of a TUE is responsible, together with his/her Federation, to submit his/her request to the FIG no later than 30 days before the start of this competition,

No TUE request will be accepted nor approved on spot, except for duly justified emergency cases. Doping controls will be made as per the Doping Control Regulations of the FIG and WADA.

The FIG and its Athletes' Representative for Parkour, Ms. Micaela BUONO Pugh, invite athletes from all participating Federations to the Athletes' meeting. All athletes are more than very welcome. Additional information will be included in the Workplan.
