2.2 Competition Format

Qualifying Competition (QC) - Juniors

3-5 gymnasts in the team, 4 compete on each apparatus, 3 best scores count.

Qualification for All Around Final and Apparatus Finals

Final result for team ranking.

Qualifying Competition (QC) - Seniors

3-5 gymnasts in the team, 4 compete on each apparatus, 3 scores count.

Qualification for Team Finals and Apparatus Finals.

This competition will be used as a Qualification competition for the 2020 Olympic Games in Tokyo

The 2 best ranked All-Around athletes **who are still eligible for an Olympic quota place**, with a maximum of one (1) per NOC, will obtain a quota place based on the results of the WAG QC. FIG will confirm and publish a separate ranking list after the QC (All-Around final ranking from Qualifications with all participating gymnasts), detailing the athletes who have obtained the quota places for Tokyo 2020 at the 2020 WAG European Championships.

All-Around Final (AAF) - Juniors

The highest 24 ranked gymnasts from the QC (with a maximum of 2 per NF) will qualify for this competition. Four (4) reserve gymnasts will be named from the ranking in the QC.

Team Final (TF) - Seniors

The best 8 teams in the QC will qualify for the Team Final.

5 gymnasts in the team, 3 compete on each apparatus with all 3 scores counting towards the team score.

Apparatus Finals (AF) - Juniors and Seniors

The 8 highest ranked gymnasts on each apparatus in the QC, with a maximum of 2 gymnasts per NF per apparatus will qualify.

Three (3) reserve gymnasts are named on each apparatus.

The warm-up for Apparatus Finals for Juniors' is run as per FIG WAG CoP Modifications for Junior Competitions.

2.2.1 Registration changes

According to Art. 6 of the FIG/TR.









2.2.2 Qualifying competition - Juniors and Seniors

- According to the FIG/TR, in case of a tie in points at any place in QC, for qualification for the Finals and in the Finals, the tie breaking rules will apply.
- Starting orders for competitions will be according to the drawing of lots carried out in Lausanne on 7th April 2020 and published by European Gymnastics.
- For the Seniors' and Juniors' QC, the draw for mixed groups will be made from the National Federations with individual gymnast(s). The starting order of the teams and mixed groups will be made by drawing of lots according the European Gymnastics/TR:
- For the Seniors' and Juniors' QC, the draw is open for all subdivisions.
- If a NF has made a nominative inscription with a team and presents only individuals at the competition or if the number of individuals at the competition is less than the number of gymnasts detailed in the nominative inscription, the European Gymnastics/WTC is entitled to make adjustments of the starting order of the competition, to reflect the actual number of gymnasts present at the competition.
- **Team:** The competing order for gymnasts in a team is decided by the National Federation.
- **Mixed group:** NF with more than one gymnast must submit the starting order for their gymnasts on each apparatus.
- The competing order of the teams/mixed groups will not alternate during the competition. The gymnasts in the first team/mixed group will warm up and compete, then the gymnasts of the second team/group will warm up and compete. The team/mixed group will compete in the same order in the subsequent apparatus.
- If a gymnast is not competing on all apparatus, she has the right to leave the competition area and warm up in the warm up hall, however, she should ensure to return to the competition hall in sufficient time for her next apparatus.





2.2.3 Team Final - Seniors

- According to the FIG/TR, in case of a tie in points at any place in the TF the tie breaking rules will apply.
- For the TF, two (2) teams will compete on each apparatus. Each Team will have a touch warm-up. The Team who is competing first (as per the starting order) will do their touch warm-up first. When the first Team finished their touch warm-up the second Team will commence their touch warm-up. The timer will indicate the start and end time of each touch warm-up. Only teams who are doing their touch warm-up are entitled to be on the Podium.
- In the competition, Teams will not compete in one block; they will compete as described in the FIG TR – see example below:
- Example 1: competition starting order 1. SUI 2. GER 3. SUI 4. GER 5. SUI 6. GER. Touch warm-up 1. SUI-SUI-SUI immediately followed by 2. GER-GER-GER
- Example 2: competition starting order 1. GER 2. SUI 3. GER 4. SUI 5. GER 6. SUI. Touch warm-up 1. GER-GER-GER immediately followed by 2. SUI-SUI-SUI
- The numbers correspond with the ranking of the teams after the qualifying competition
- If a gymnast is not competing on all apparatus, she has the right to leave the competition area and warm up in the warm up hall, however, she should ensure to return to the competition hall in sufficient time for her next apparatus.

2.2.5 Apparatus Finals - Juniors and Seniors

- According to the FIG/TR, in case of a tie in points at any place in the Apparatus Finals, for qualification for the Finals and in the Finals, the tie breaking rules will apply.
- The draw for the starting order for AF was carried out in Paris on 7th February 2020 by the European Gymnastics WTC.
- If more than 8 gymnasts qualify for one apparatus final, a draw will take place to determine the starting order.
- If a gymnast competes in two (or more) successive Apparatus Finals and medals in the preceding Final (thus reducing the gymnasts' opportunity to return to the warm up hall prior to the next Final), the WTC will (if necessary) adjust the start order. As a result, the start order for the Final following the medal presentation may be amended.

2.3 Touch warm-up during the competition

Warm-up times according to the FIG rules.

- Qualifying Competition and Apparatus Finals juniors - on the podium.
- Qualifying competition and Team Final seniors - on the podium.
- Apparatus Finals seniors in the warm-up hall **only**. (Prior to the start of the Apparatus Final, a timed/controlled warm-up period of one hour is accorded to the gymnasts and will take place on the podium up to 30 minutes before the start of the competition).

2.4 Access to the competition area

The competition area is accessible to members of various juries, competing gymnasts and their accredited coaches, to local group leaders, to the auxiliary personnel of the Jury, to the President of the European Gymnastics Medical Commission, to the official doctor, to the team doctors, medical staff and to persons concerned with the apparatus. A team medical person is permitted to accompany the gymnasts and coaches during all competitions.

Interpreters may not enter the competition area without the permission of Mrs. Anca Mihailescu-Grigoras, President of European Gymnastics/WTC. The competition area is strictly forbidden to all other persons. Concerning the presence of the coaches and medical team on the podium the following provisions will apply:

- Each team in QC and TF may be assisted in the competition area by not more than 2 coaches. For individual gymnasts only 1 coach per gymnast is allowed (maximum 2 coaches).
- For AF competition only 1 coach per gymnast is allowed
- For all competitions, 1 team medical person per national federation is allowed.

2.5 Use of electronic devices (European Gymnastics/TR Art. 13.1)

The use of mobile phones or any other electronic communication device by gymnasts, coaches, judges or medical staff of the delegations on the field of play is forbidden during the duration of official European Gymnastics competitions. If this rule is violated, the persons concerned will receive a written warning. If this behaviour is repeated after the written warning is issued, the persons concerned will be excluded for the rest of the competition. The Superior Jury is responsible to decide these disciplinary measures. Appeals against these decisions have to be submitted to the Jury of Appeal, whose decision is final.

2.6 Award ceremonies

The award ceremonies will take place according to the schedule and will be organised as follows:

- Qualifying Competition: Juniors (team ranking): Gold, Silver and Bronze medallists on podium
- All Around Final Juniors: Gold, Silver and Bronze medallists on podium
- Team Final Seniors: Gold, Silver and Bronze medallists on podium
- Apparatus Finals Juniors: Gold, Silver and Bronze medallists on podium
- Apparatus Finals Seniors: Gold, Silver and Bronze medallists on podium

According to the FIG/TR, the gymnasts are requested to wear **tracksuit** during the award ceremonies. The participation of the medal winners in the award ceremonies is compulsory. Gymnasts or teams that are absent for unjustified reasons will be disqualified.

2.7 Apparatus supplier

The apparatus supplier for this European Championships is Gymnova.

Additional landing mats for all apparatus will be provided by the apparatus supplier in the warm up halls and for podium training. In addition, the federations are allowed to bring small protection mats/pads/coverings only. These mats/pads/coverings (e.g. carpet mats, beam protection pad) must not be thicker than 5cm and not bigger than 1.50m x 1m. These mats/pads/coverings can be used during (podium) training and warm up, but not for the touch warm up.

2.8 Scoring and distribution of results

After each competition the results will be provided on the following website:

www.europeangymnastics.com. In addition, it will be sent to each Head of Delegation by e-mail.

At the end of all competitions, all delegations will be provided with a complete set of results including the judges' individual scores.

2.9 Orientation meeting

The Orientation meeting will be held on Monday 27.04.2020 at 19h30 – 20:30 at Arena Sports Bar of the Venue. The presence of the participating NF at the orientation meeting is mandatory. A maximum of three members per delegation is permitted, including the Head of Delegation. Unjustified failure to attend will result in a sanction against the federation of Euro 1,000.

2.10 Competitions numbers (Bib)

Two (2) sets of starting numbers will be provided to the Head of Delegation by Paris 2020. These will be available from the delegation boxes at the sport information desk after the orientation meeting. The numbers have to be firmly attached to the leotard/unitard throughout the entire competition.

2.11 Written exercises

It would be appreciated if NF submit their gymnasts' exercises in symbols notation, before the podium training, at the very latest.

2.12 New elements

New elements should be submitted by e-mail to Mrs. Anca Mihailescu-Grigoras agrigroras@romgym.ro, the President of the Superior Jury, before April 15, 2020, or at the very latest 24 hours before the podium training. A technical drawing and a video have to be attached to the e-mail (see FIG NL No. 42).

2.13 Anti-doping control

Any doping is prohibited. An anti-doping control can be requested at any time. Anti-doping controls will be as per Anti-Doping Control Regulations of FIG and WADA.

The Jury of Appeal is composed of two members of the European Gymnastics Executive Committee (one of them acting as President) and a member of the LOC who was not involved in the decision of the Superior Jury and the judging process on the concerned apparatus.



3.3 Apparatus Jury





All registered judges must hold a valid FIG judges brevet. To be allowed to judge, the judges must have taken part in the judges' instruction, in the drawing of lots and in the briefings preceding the competition. In cases where there is an insufficient number of judges from the participating present NF, the European Gymnastics/WTC will decide the process for designating the necessary number of judges.

If a NF has a judge selected in the D2-Jury, its other registered judge can be drawn as E-judge or assistant in a Junior and/or Senior competition if needed (cannot be on the same apparatus). If there are not enough judges in a Junior and/or Senior competition, it is possible to use the same judge in both competitions.

3.3.1 D-Jury

- D1-judges (Difficulty Judges) were drawn by the European Gymnastics/WTC in Prague on 30th November 2019 from the list of European Category I Judges.
- D2-judges (Difficulty Judges) were drawn by the European Gymnastics/WTC in Paris on 7th February 2020 (after the definitive registration) from those with FIG Brevet category I and II.
- D1- and D2-judges remain the same throughout the entire competition in Juniors and in Seniors and are detailed as follows:

3.3.2 E-Jury

- E-judges (Execution Judges) will be decided by the drawing of lots on site.
- The E-jury consists of five (5) E-judges. The final E-score will be determined from the three middle scores.
- For AF Juniors and Seniors, only judges from federations without qualified gymnasts (including the first reserve) will be allowed to judge in the E-Jury at the concerned apparatus.
- All entered judges must be available until the drawing of lots for the last competition of the respective European Championships. Exceptions will be managed by Mrs. Anca Mihailescu-Grigoras, the President of the European Gymnastics/WTC.
- If needed, judges registered for the Senior competitions will be used also for Junior competitions and vice versa.
- Cat 4 judges, if present, are only allowed to judge line and time.
- ➔ As a reminder and according to the European Gymnastics/TR, the function of a judge cannot be combined with any other function.

3.3.3 R-Jury

- R-judges (Reference Judges) were drawn by the European Gymnastics/WTC in Paris on 7th February 2020 (after the definitive registration) from those judges with FIG Brevet category I and II.
- In Apparatus Finals the R-Jury must be neutral.

3.4 Judges' instruction and drawing of lots

According to the European Gymnastics/TR, the presence of the judges at the judges' instruction is mandatory. The judges' instruction will be held in English. The judges' oath will be carried out at the end of the judges' instruction by one of the host federation's judges.

3.5 Inquiries of the score

European Gymnastics applies the TR/FIG, Article 8.4.

The detailed procedure is laid down in the Technical Regulations of the FIG.

If the inquiry is refused, the amount will be invoiced by European Gymnastics (in Euro, not in USD).

4. ORGANISATION OF THE EVENT

4.1 Training information

Two sessions of training will be provided to the participating federations. The minimum time between the two daily training sessions for a group must be 3.5 hours.

A detailed program of the training will be provided to the participating NF after the draw. The delegations are obliged to respect the training schedules.

Training upon request will be possible on Sunday, 26th from 4.00 PM to 8.00 PM (hall 2 and 3 only). Please submit the request form to the LOC by 31st March 2020.

D-jury (D1- and D2-judges) may attend all training sessions.

E-judges may only attend training sessions at which their team is in attendance.

4.2 Official podium training

A detailed program of the official podium training will be provided to the participating NF.

The presence of all judges at the official podium training is mandatory.

4.3 Delegation

Gymnasts who are not the correct age and do not hold a valid FIG license (or the validity of license is expired) are not allowed to compete.

The total number of coaches may not be higher than the total number of gymnasts

4.4 Accreditation

The accreditation office will be located at the competition venue. Upon accreditation, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative will have to provide the following:

- The passport of the gymnasts and judges
- The licences of gymnasts, judges and medical staff
- Proof of insurance coverage of the delegation (except gymnasts and judges)
- Proof of the fulfilment of all financial obligations to the LOC (accommodation, meals)
- Floor music and "music release form", if not sent to the LOC previously
 - o Hand in one set of back-up audio CDs or USB key of their gymnasts' floor exercise music, including for each USB key the name of the NF and the 3 capital letters used by FIG for the country code, the name of the gymnast, the name of the composer and of the title of the music and the exact length of the music. These back-up audio CDs or USB key must be brought for safety reasons, and will be returned at the closing banquet
 - o An additional audio CDs or USB key has to be brought for the training sessions.
- Hand in the request for raising the bars by 10 cm
- "Confirmation of the national flag and anthem" form
- Departure confirmation
