- THE HOST COUNTRY IS GUARANTEED 1 ALL-AROUND GYMNAST QUOTA PLACE, IF NOT ALREADY QUALIFIED WITH A TEAM OR AN APPARATUS GYMNAST.
- THE 8 HIGHEST TEAMS FROM LIVERPOOL 2022, BASED ON THE TEAMS' RANKING RESULTS OF THE QUALIFICATIONS, WILL AUTOMATICALLY QUALIFY FOR THE 2023 WCH

ONCE CONFIRMED BY THE NF, ANY UNUSED TEAM QUOTA PLACES WILL NOT BE REALLOCATED

A NF UNABLE TO USE ITS CONFIRMED TEAM QUOTA PLACE WILL STILL BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE WCH WITH A MAXIMUM OF 2 INDIVIDUAL GYMNASTS (EITHER ALL-AROUND GYMNASTS OR APPARATUS GYMNASTS).

THE REALLOCATION PROCEDURE FOR INDIVIDUAL GYMNAST WILL END

5 DAYS BEFORE THE OFFICIAL ARRIVAL DAY


THE GYMNAST DRAWING OF LOTS MAY BE CONDUCTED ONCE THE QUALIFIED TEAMS AND INDIVIDUAL GYMNASTS ARE CONFIRMED BY THE NFS

• TEAMS AND ALL-AROUND GYMNASTS WILL BE DRAWN BY NF

- APPARATUS SPECIALISTS WILL BE DRAWN BY NAME
 - THE 2 GROUPS OF APPARATUS SPECIALISTS WILL CONTAIN DIFFERENT GYMNASTS ON EACH APPARATUS
 - IF QUALIFIED ON CONSECUTIVE APPARATUS, A GYMNAST COMPETING LAST ON ONE APPARATUS WILL NOT BE DRAWN TO COMPETE FIRST OR SECOND ON THE FOLLOWING APPARATUS

5.A TRAININGS



- TIMED TRAININGS FOR WAG
- WAG GYMNASTS IN SUB 1 AND 2 MAY TRAIN ON THE OFFICIAL ARRIVAL DAY OF SUB 3 TO 10
- TRAINING SESSIONS WILL OVERLAP
- THE STRETCHING AREA WILL BE USED FOR THE GYMNASTS' GENERAL WARM-UP.



• FREE TRAININGS FOR MAG <u>BUT TIMED TRAININGS FOR THE APPARATUS SPECIALISTS</u>



- MAG AND WAG APPARATUS SPECIALISTS CAN ONLY TRAIN ON THE APPARATUS THEY QUALIFIED FOR.
- THEY WILL STILL HAVE THE POSSIBILITY TO TRAIN ON THE OTHER APPARATUS DURING DAILY DEDICATED OPEN TRAINING SESSIONS (UNTIL THE END OF THE QUALIFICATIONS).

THE BEST 3 TEAMS FROM THE TEAM FINAL QUALIFY TO PARIS 2024 (CRITERIA 1)





ONLY GYMNASTS WHO COMPETE ON <u>ALL APPARATUS</u> IN <u>QUALIFICATIONS CAN QUALIFY FOR THE ALL-AROUND FINAL</u>

THIS INCLUDES THE APPARATUS SPECIALISTS WHO MAY HAVE QUALIFIED ON ALL 6 APPARATUS FOR MEN AND ALL 4 APPARATUS FOR WOMEN FOR THE WCH







ALLOWED ON THE FOP BEFORE COMPETING ON EACH APPARATUS IN TWO GROUPS AS PER THE STARTING ORDER:

- GYMNASTS 1, 2, 3, 4 TOUCH WARM-UP AND COMPETE FIRST
- GYMNASTS 5, 6, 7, 8 TOUCH WARM-UP AND COMPETE SECOND

 ADDITIONAL TAC FOR COACH AND MEDICAL STAFF MAY BE DELIVERED BY FIG UPON NF REQUEST FOR ZONE 1 DURING QUALIFICATIONS IN CASE INDIVIDUAL GYMNASTS COMPETE IN MORE THAN 2 DIFFERENT ROTATIONS IN THE SAME SUBDIVISION.



• 1 ADDITIONAL TAC FOR COACH AND MEDICAL STAFF MAY BE DELIVERED BY FIG UPON NF REQUEST FOR ZONE 1 DURING ALL-AROUND FINAL IN CASE THE 2 GYMNASTS QUALIFIED COMPETE IN DIFFERENT ROTATIONS AND ONLY IF 1 TAC FOR COACH AND 1 FOR MEDICAL STAFF WAS ORIGINALLY ISSUED.



• 1 ADDITIONAL TAC MAY BY DELIVERED BY FIG UPON NF REQUEST FOR ZONE 3 TO THE HEAD OF DELEGATION / TEAM MANAGERS IN CASE MAG AND WAG GYMNASTS FROM THE SAME NF COMPETE ON THE SAME DAY IN APPARATUS FINALS.



IN ANY CASE, THE TOTAL NUMBER OF COACHES AND MEDICAL STAFF ON THE FIELD OF PLAY MAY NOT EXCEED THE TOTAL NUMBER OF AA GYMNAST(S) AND APPARATUS GYMNAST(S) COMPETING PER APPARATUS.
