

COVID - 19 PROCEDURES

Dear Gymnastics Friends,

We take this opportunity to inform You about Covid - 19 procedures during FIG World Challenge Cup Osijek (Osijek - CRO, June 10 - 13, 2021.)

ARRIVAL

To participate in the FIG WCC Osijek 2021. and for the entry to Croatia, all delegation members need to bring one of the following:

- 1. a negative PCR test or quick antigen test result (done max. 48h before arrival), readable in English, to the accreditation for each delegation member
- 2. vaccination certificate for persons who have received 14 days from the day of vaccination with the second dose of COVID-19 vaccine (Pfizer or AstraZeneca) or from single-dose vaccination (Johnson), in the case of a single dose vaccine
- 3. positive PCR or quick antigen test, confirming that the person has recovered from SARS-CoV-2 virus infection, which test was performed 180 days ago, and older than 11 days from the date of arrival at the border crossing or
- 4. presentation of a certificate of recovering form COVID 19 issued by a physician/doctor

DURING THE EVENT

The use of disposable masks inside the venue is mandatory for all accredited persons. It is the responsibility of the delegations to bring a sufficient number of masks.

The LOC will arrange all local transport by shuttle busses, respecting the time schedule of the Event.

While eating (breakfast, lunch or dinner), team members must remain same sitting arrangement.

The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.



The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout.

Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at thetraining venue or on the FOP and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.

The LOC will check the body temperatures and health conditions of gymnasts, coaches, judges, and other personnel every time they enter the venue.

The FIG also requests gymnasts and coaches to avoid risky habits on the FOP. The unsafe practices related to virus transmission are:

- > Spitting on the hands before performances
- Shaking hands with or hugging others
- ➤ Sharing magnesium carbonate with others. Depending on the discipline, the use of liquid chalk (70%–80% alcohol) instead of classical magnesium carbonate is recommended, otherwise every participant should receive, use and maintain their own personal magnesium.
- Any close physical interaction than absolutely necessary between gymnasts and coaches

The LOC will prepare the necessary arrangements of eventual quarantine / positive Covid-19 cases. In the case of a positive PCR test for Covid-19 the person must remain quarantined for 10 days and the contacts of the infected person (roommate) in self-isolation for 10 days. Nonetheless, the responsibility for eventual quarantine and/or positive Covid-19 cases concerning their delegation remains with the NF. This includes the covering of all costs.

DEPARTURE

If delegation members need or wish to do a PCR test at the end of the event before their travel back home, they have the possibility to do so. NF will have to inform the LOC about this in advance by sending email to Mr. Damir Jankovic – booking.zito@gmail.com (deadline: May 31st 2021). Cost of PCR testing is 100 € per person.

Payment will be possible by bank transfer or in cash upon arrival.
