AGE LIMITS	AG1: 12-14 Years / AG2-Juniors 15-17 years / Seniors 18 + years									
JUDGES & JURIES	<p>The number of Juries (judges' panels) may be decided by the Organizing Member Federation depending on the number of participating competitors and judges.</p> <p>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet.</p> <p>The Juries are set up by a draw and directed by the Technical Delegate from the judges present at the event. Priority will be given to the judges of the highest category. If, on the day of the competition, there are no sufficient numbers of judges in the requested categories, the Technical Delegate may take whatever action needed to secure the running of the event. Each participating federation must provide minimum one judge Cat. 1, 2, 3 or 4 with current valid brevet. Failure to do so, will result in a fine of CHF 2'000.- to be paid to the LOC until the Definitive Registration date (20-01-2021).</p>									
REGISTRATION DEADLINES	<p>Provisional, Definitive and Nominative Registrations must be completed by sending the composition of the delegation to the LOC. ENTRY FEES	<p>The costs for the entry fees are: IW/IM: 30,00€ - MP: 45,00€ - TRIO:55,00€ - GROUP: 65,00€ - Aerodance Group: 70,00€</p> <p>The invited participating federations must pay for all entry fees. At the time of the Definitive entry (2 months prior to the event) 100% of the entry fee must be paid to the LOC. All the entry fees are not refundable.</p>									
EVENT FORMAT	<p>The Aerobic Gymnastics International Open Competition will have Qualifications and Finals in all categories. Aerobic Gymnastics Categories: IW, IM, MP, TR, GR & GRAD. Qualifications: Participation is not limited by nation / category / age group.</p> <p>The participation in the finals is limited to 2 units per country in each category.</p>									
ACCREDITATION	<p>In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.</p> <p>The accreditation will take place at the Sports Hall "Os Marialvas" upon arrival to Cantanhede. The accreditations will only be handed out to the Head of Delegation.</p> <p>All delegations must deliver 2 memory sticks with the musics of all routines, national anthem and flag, SPORTIVE INSURANCE declaration, passports of all members and FIG Licenses.</p>

PARTICIPATION	<p>The International Open Competition consists of qualifications and finals. There will be qualifications only for the categories and age groups with more than 9 participants. In case of a tie in any place, the tie-breaking rules are as set by FIG.</p> <p>Participation in the finals:</p> <p>The top eight units per category and age group will qualify for the Finals. In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules are the FIG World Championships Rules.</p> <p>The LOC may cancel the competition in the respective category if at the time of the definitive entry, there are less than 3 countries registered in a category. In case of such a cancelation, the LOC must reimburse, in full, the entry fee and payments made for accommodation.</p> <p>Should flights have to be cancelled due to the above, the risk is at the charge of the participating member Federations.</p>
SIZE OF THE DELEGATION AND FIG LICENSE	<p>The number of participants by nation, category and age group is not limited. All AG1 (12-14 Years), Juniors / AG2 (15-17 years) and Seniors gymnasts in good standing with the correct age and holding a valid FIG license until the end of the event, may participate.</p> <p>The LOC will be responsible for checking the validity of all gymnasts Licenses. No gymnasts will be accepted without a valid FIG License at the deadline of the Nominative Registration.</p>
CATEGORIES	IW / IM / Mix Pair / Trio / Group (all age limits) / Aerodance (AG2 & SNR)
DRAWING OF LOTS	<p>The drawing of lots will take place at the Gymnastics Federation of Portugal Federation two weeks after the closing date of the nominative registration. After publication of the draw to all participating federations there will be an opportunity to modify the position of the gymnasts' starting order within 3 days by using the official document.</p>
MEDICAL SERVICES	<p>The Local Organizing Committee will provide first aid medical services. A physiotherapist will be present during the competitions as well members of the Portuguese Red Cross specialized in first aids. Medical support is also available at 5 min. distance.</p>
COVID 19	<p>Besides the FIG medical guidelines for the particular event, FIG also requires all the participants to follow the standard precautions.</p> <p>The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible.</p> <p>The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout.</p> <p>Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres whenever possible.</p>
VISA	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Portugal Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Portugal. The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before 19, January, 2022 to the LOC. The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid</p>

	<p>insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: 40€ (forty euros) per person/day.</p>
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by 19, January, 2022.</p>
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The Organizers will arrange at a determined fee, the transport service from the LISBON International airport and OPORTO International airport to the accommodation place in Cantanhede and to the competition hall</p> <p>The costs are per person.</p> <p>Transportation from Oporto Airport to the competition venue or hotel and back – 55€ (fifty five Euros). Transportation from Lisbon Airport to the competition venue or hotel and back – 80€ (eighty Euros).</p> <p>The LOC only ensure the Local Transportation between the hotels and the hall of the competition to the participants who booked the accommodation by the LOC.</p> <p>The invited participating federations must pay for the transportation expenses of their delegation members until 19, January, 2022.</p>
