9. QUALIFICATIONS

There is no qualification if less than 9 competitors (units) in categories (IW, IM, MP, TR, GR).

10. FINALS

• New Generation, National Development, Age Group 1, Age Group 2 and Seniors: Each final (IW, IM, MP, TR, GR): maximum of ten (10) competitors: 8 best competitors (max. 2 per nation) + 2 Czech competitors (maximum).

11. RULES AND REGULATIONS

12. TRAINING AND COMPETITION AREAS

Warm-up and training areas as well as the competition podium are situated in a big multifunctional stage on the ground floor and are divided into several parts, marked 7x7m and 10x10m. The competition stage is equipped with the official aerobic floor and is divided from the training areas by the background. Please, note that there will be no music in training areas as it could disturb the podium training and the competition. The Podium trainings will be organized according to the schedule (App 1). There will be 1 training session:

• Training session 1 - Friday 8th of August for the athletes who are competing in the Qualifications rounds (Friday and Saturday); time per routine 1min 30 s.

Nations are requested to fill in the respective forms for the Order of the training (**App 2**) and sendit to kocova@gymfed.cz by April 5th the latest.

13. MUSIC

In order to simplify the management of the music and to limit the technical problems the federations are asked to submit the music in MP3 format **ONLINE** http://admin.gymaerobic.com Each music file will have to contain the following information:

- The name of the nation (official abbreviation of the country);
- The first and last name of the competitor/s;
- The category (IM, IW, MP, TR, GR, AS, AD);
- The Junior or Senior

Delegation members are requested to keep in their possession a USB key of their music for their podium training sessions and in case of a technical problems.

14. OPENING CEREMONY

The official opening ceremony will take place on **Saturday**, **9**th **of April from 09:15 before the beginning of the Qualifications**. Further information will be given during the Orientation Meeting.

15. AWARD CEREMONIES

The ceremonies will take place in the competition venue according to the competition schedule. For all award ceremonies gymnasts must wear their national tracksuits.

16. INSURANCE AND MEDICAL SERVICES

The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.

The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.

The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance. During the Trainings and Competitions the LOC will provide medical services. Appointed person will be available during those times.

18. MEALS

Meals will be served at the SC Řepy venue – in the Hotel part with the restaurant right next to the competition hall. For those of you, who ordered meals through LOC, the meals will be served in these time slots starting with dinner on 7th April:

DINNER: 19:00 - 21:00 (with the exception on 10. 4.: 18:00 – 20:00)

19. LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

The LOC will provide transportation from the official hotels to the competition hall and back. Delegations will receive the time schedule of the buses. Further information will be given during the Orientation Meeting.

20. ENTERING CZECH REPUBLIC AND RETURNING BACK HOME

Each Nation has already received information on the requirements for entering our country. This information should be strictly followed so there are no problems when coming in Czech Republic.

We would like to remind you that you are obliged:

- to fill in the <u>e-border form before</u> arriving in Czech Republic https://plf.uzis.cz/

We suggest that each Nation checks the requirements to enter their country when going back from Czech Republic. Depending on the requirements of your country you can do PCR test organized by LOC. This information has been already distributed to the delegations. **Please, let us know if you request the testing if you haven't done it yet as soon as possible.**

The price for PCR test is 45 € per person. The price for ATG test is 15 € per person.

21. DISTRIBUTION OF INFORMATION, RESULTS, SCHEDULES

Each Nation is responsible to have the Work Plan in advance. Only changes to it and additional/ new schedules will be handed with one set of updated Starting tables for Qualifications (updatesafter the accreditation) will be given to each Nation at the end of the Orientation meeting. In addition, it will be sent to all by e-mail to the e-mail address given during the accreditation. The same will be done with the Starting tables for the Finals, Friday evening by e-mail and later. The complete set of Results will be sent to each participating Federation by e- mail, after the competition is over.
