OPENING

The official opening of the European Championships Munich 2022 will take place in Olympiapark on **10 August 2022 at 18:30**, whetting the appetite for 11 action-packed days of high-profile sports and the colourful festival programme.

Olympiapark is one of the most sustainable Olympic sites worldwide and has hosted international music and sports greats, locals, and tourists alike over the past five decades. It is the perfect venue for the opening, which will see the entire park undergo a transformation in three phases: dreamy calm, awakening and shining life. The emphasis is on unexpected and surprising moments, as walking acts, light shows, bands, and many more will take the visitors on an audio-visual journey. Renowned rap artist Marteria and Munich-based brass band Moop Mama will headline the music performances at the Central Roof, with the Central Stage floating on Olympiasee. The opening rings in Munich 2022 and unites all visitors in a celebration of life, filling Olympiapark with plentiful new memories.



All athletes are kindly invited to attend the official opening. To have guaranteed access to the lawn steps ("Rasenstufen") at the Central Stage and enjoy a front-row experience, athletes are asked to pick up a wristband at the Athlete Roof @ Red Bull Energy Station. The wristbands can be collected on 10 August 2022 until 19:00.

Please note that there won't be any dedicated shuttles to and from the opening. All attendees are kindly asked to take public transport, which can be used free of charge with a Munich 2022 accreditation.

CLOSING PARTY

The Closing Party of the European Championships Munich 2022 will take place on **21 August 2022 starting at 22:30** at Olympiastadion. Every team member is welcome to attend! Please note that you will need a special wristband to access the party. Team Leaders will be informed about the distribution of the wristbands in due time.

FAREWELL BANQUET

We warmly welcome you to the Farewell Banquet, which will take place on **14 August** for WAG Teams and on **21 August** for MAG Teams, starting at **20:30** in the Olympiahalle. 
OLYMPIAHALLE: GYMNASTICS ATHLETE LOUNGE

The exact shuttle times can be found at the Hotel Welcome Desks, at the Delegation Information Desk and via the Gymnastics team website (see page 1 for the QR code).










UNITING AND DIVERSE EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS - UNITING AND DIVERSE MUNICH

TICKETS

ATHLETES' TICKETS

In the spirit of the multi-sport event, accredited athletes will have the opportunity to attend events of all nine sports free of charge.

Reservations are generally not possible, and access will be granted onsite and is subject to availability. In general, no tickets will be issued. On site, the athlete can enter the venue through a specially assigned entrance (usually located at the main entrance). Admission will be granted upon presentation of a valid EC2022 accreditation.

There is no fixed entitlement to a seat. As soon as the ticket holder claims her or his seat, the athlete must release the seat and find an alternative available seat. In most venues there will be a designated area for athletes.

The current sales status can be viewed in the European Championships 2022 webshop. By clicking on the corresponding session, the sales status can be seen.

To allow other athletes to access the venue, it is important to use the exclusive entrance again when exiting the venue. This will ensure that the ticketing volunteer frees up a space in the system and another athlete has the opportunity to visit the event.

SPECTATORS' TICKETS

As a multi-sport event, European Championships Munich 2022 hosts nine different sports. There are numerous other sports spectators can enjoy and buy tickets for. Some sports are even free of charge.

DRINKING WATER

For reasons of sustainability, we are glad to be able to offer our Officials and Judges tap water as drinking water. Tap water in Germany is drinkable. The LOC asks all participants to use reusable water bottles, which can be refilled at taps at the venue. Each official will get his/her own reusable bottle by the LOC.

WASTE MANAGEMENT & CLEANLINESS ON THE SITE

Our Waste management is based on the principles: rethink, reduce, reuse, recycle. In this sense, all together we try to produce as less waste as possible and avoid littering. For recycling we will set up waste stations to sort the waste by type. Additionally, standard bins have been placed at the venue for residual garbage collection. All attendees are encouraged to use the recycling waste stations and bins throughout the venue.

SUSTAINABILITY



BACK TO THE ROOFS: A TIMETRAVEL OF 50 YEARS



Munich 2022 is an innovative return to the roots of the 1972 Olympic Games. A reminiscence of hospitality, happiness, and community, but also of the victims of the attack on the Israeli Olympic team. The event also stands for a return to a unique and historic location. A return to the legendary architecture of Olympiapark with its world-famous tent roof structure, which once transformed Munich, a village of a million, into an international sports metropolis overnight. This coming home is described by the slogan of the European Championships 2022. "Back to the roofs" is more than a call to come back to Olympiapark, it is a promise to embrace the legacy of the 1972 Olympic Games and to interpret it in a modern and new way.
