1.1 COVID-19 measures

1.2 Responsibilities

Should the event have to be cancelled at a later stage, the LOC will try its' best to handle the force majeure situation with the reimbursement of costs for accommodation and meal bookings. However, the financial responsibility for all bookings (travel, accommodation, meals) remains with the NF.

In order to maintain the safety of everyone participating in the event it is the responsibility of the NF that all of their delegation members commit to fully respect the Covid-19 measures. We are convinced the Covid-19 risks can be brought to a minimum by doing this. Nonetheless, the responsibility for eventual quarantine and/or positive Covid19 cases concerning their delegation remains with the NF. This includes the covering of all costs.

2.2 Competition Format

The FIG requirements for Juniors and for Seniors will be applied for all phases of competitions.

Event ID, Senior: 16904

Event ID, Junior: 17008

According to FIG TR 2022, the 2022 European Championships is a qualifying event for the World Championships. For details, see the FIG TR **Art. 5.1.1 Qualifications Pathway to the World Championships**.

QUALIFYING COMPETITION

Seniors - Qualifying Competition incl. All-Around Final, plus qualification for Team Final and Apparatus Finals.

Juniors - Qualifying Competition incl. All-Around and Team Final, plus qualification for Apparatus Finals

A Senior and Junior team consists of 3 - 5 gymnasts, of which up to 4 gymnasts compete on each apparatus. The 3 best scores on each apparatus are added together to make the team total on that apparatus. The NF nominates the team on each apparatus.

If a Federation does not have a sufficient number of gymnasts for a full team, it is possible to participate with Individual gymnasts.

The results of the Senior & Junior Qualifying Competition will determine the All-Around Senior / Junior European Artistic Gymnastics Champion 2022. A separate All-Around Final result list will be produced which will detail the top 24 gymnasts with the highest All-Around ranking. A maximum of 2 gymnasts per Federation will be taken into consideration.

The results from the Junior Qualifying competition will also determine the Junior European Artistic Gymnastics Team Champions 2022. A separate Team Final result list will be produced which will detail the top 8 Teams with the highest Team total ranking. In the event of a tie in any place in the Team Final & All-Around Final results and in line with the FIG Technical Regulations for Juniors, the tie will not be broken.

SENIORS - Team Final

The 8 best Teams from the Qualifying Competition will participate in the Team Final. A Team consists of 3 to 5 gymnasts. 3 gymnasts will compete on each apparatus with all 3 scores counting towards the total score for the Team on that apparatus.

SENIORS & JUNIORS - Apparatus Finals

The 8 highest ranked gymnasts on each apparatus from the Qualifying Competition will qualify for the respective Apparatus Final. A maximum of two gymnasts per federation will be allowed in the finals.

RESERVE GYMNASTS:

For the Apparatus Finals, three (3) Reserve gymnasts will be designated by taking into account the respective Apparatus ranking results in the Qualification Competition.

If called upon, a reserve gymnast will work in accordance with the order of the gymnast she replaces. Reserves must be prepared to compete and must be present in the warm-up hall in case they are called upon.

2.2.1 Registration changes

According to Art. 6 of the FIG / TR.

Forms must be submitted to Mrs Anca Mihailescu-Grigoras, the European Gymnastics WTC President via the Delegation Information Desk.

2.2.2 Qualifying Competition - Juniors and Seniors

According to the FIG / TR, in case of a tie in points at any place in the QC, for qualification to the Finals and in the Finals, the tie breaking rules will apply.

Starting orders for competitions will be according to the drawing of lots carried out in Lausanne on **7th July 2022** and published by European Gymnastics.

For the Seniors' and Juniors' QC, the draw for Mixed Groups will be made from the National Federations with individual gymnast(s). The starting order of the Teams and Mixed Groups will be made by the drawing of lots according to the European Gymnastics/TR:

For the Seniors' QC the draw will start with the 4 highest ranked European Teams from the Qualification Competition at the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games. The Teams are:

- FRA, BEL, GBR & ITA (Reserve GER)

The 4 ranked Teams will be drawn in the final subdivision and placed horizontally across the apparatus working in Olympic order.

For Juniors' QC, the draw is open for all subdivisions.

If a NF has made a nominative inscription with a team and presents with only individuals at the competition or if the number of individuals at the competition is less than the number of gymnasts detailed in the nominative inscription, the European Gymnastics / WTC is entitled to adjust the starting order of the competition, to reflect the actual number of gymnasts present at the competition.

Teams: The competing order for gymnasts in a team is decided by the National Federation.

Mixed Group: NF with more than one gymnast within a Mixed Group must submit the Starting Order for their gymnasts on each apparatus. A Federation can only choose the order if they have two gymnasts in a Mixed Group. If a Federation has only Individual gymnasts and one of their gymnasts does not compete on an apparatus, the Federation can choose which position to compete in.

The competing order of the Teams / Mixed Groups will **NOT** alternate during the Qualification Competition – example as follows - **Rotation 1** AUT, Mixed Group, **Rotation 2** AUT, Mixed Group.

The gymnasts in the first Team / Mixed Group will warm-up and compete, then the gymnasts of the second Team / Mixed Group will warm-up and compete.

The competing order for NF with Individual gymnasts inside a Mixed Group **WILL** rotate in the Qualification Competition– example as follows - **Rotation 1** – ISL, ISL, NOR, NOR – **Rotation 2** – ISL, NOR, NOR, ISL.

If a gymnast is not competing on all apparatus she has the right to leave the competition area and return to the warm-up hall, however, she should ensure to return to the competition hall in sufficient time for her next apparatus.

2.2.3 Team Final - Seniors

According to the FIG/TR, in case of a tie in points at any place in the TF the tie breaking rules will apply.

For the TF, two (2) teams will compete on each apparatus. Each Team will have a touch warm-up. The Team who is competing first (as per the starting order) will do their touch warm-up first. When the first Team is finished their touch warm-up the second Team will commence their touch warm-up. The timer will indicate the start and end time of each touch warm-up. Only teams who are doing their touch warm-up are entitled to be on the Podium.

In the competition, Teams will not compete in one block; they will compete as described in the FIG TR – see example below.

The numbers correspond with the ranking of the teams after the Qualifying Competition. If a gymnast is not

competing on all apparatus, she has the right to leave the competition area and warm-up in the warmup hall, however, she should ensure to return to the competition hall in sufficient time for her next apparatus.

2.2.5 Apparatus Finals - Juniors and Seniors

According to the FIG/TR, in case of a tie in points at any place in the Apparatus Finals, for qualification for the Finals and in the Finals, the tie breaking rules will apply.

The draw for the starting order for AF was carried out in Oslo on 17th June 2022 by the European Gymnastics WTC.

If more than 8 gymnasts qualify for one apparatus final, a draw will take place to determine the starting order. If a gymnast competes in two (or more) successive Apparatus Finals and medals in the preceding Final (thus reducing the gymnasts' opportunity to return to the warm-up hall prior to the next Final), the WTC will (if necessary) adjust the start order. As a result, the start order for the Final following the medal presentation may be amended.

2.3 Touch warm-up during the competition

- Warm-up times according to the FIG rules.
- Qualifying Competition and Apparatus Finals Juniors - on the Podium.
- In Apparatus Finals Juniors, the first 4 gymnasts will warm-up and compete followed by the remaining 4 gymnasts, warm-up and compete.
- Qualifying Competition, Team Final & Apparatus Finals Seniors - on the Podium.
- In Apparatus Finals Seniors, all 8 gymnasts will warm-up and afterwards compete.
- Prior to the start of Apparatus Finals, a timed warm-up period of one hour is accorded to the gymnasts on the Podium. This warm-up will end 30 / 25 minutes before the start of the competition.

2.4 Access to the competition area

The competition area is accessible to members of various juries, competing gymnasts and their accredited coaches, to local group leaders, to the auxiliary personnel of the Jury, to the President of the European Gymnastics Medical Commission, to the official doctor, to the team doctors, medical staff and to persons concerned with the apparatus. A team medical person is permitted to accompany the gymnasts and coaches during all competitions.

Interpreters may not enter the competition area without the permission of Mrs. Anca Mihailescu-Grigoras, President of European Gymnastics / WTC. The competition area is strictly forbidden to all other persons.

Concerning the presence of the coaches and medical team on the podium the following provisions will apply:

- Each Team in QC and TF may be assisted in the competition area by not more than 2 coaches.
- For individual gymnasts only 1 coach per gymnast is allowed (maximum 2 coaches).
- For AF Competition only 1 coach per gymnast is allowed
- For all competitions, 1 team medical person per national federation is allowed.

2.5 Use of electronic devices (European Gymnastics/TR Art. 13.1)

During the duration of official European Gymnastics competitions, which is defined as starting the moment the first gymnast enters the field of play and ending the moment the last score is made public:

- Judges on the field of play are absolutely prohibited from using cellular phones / tablets and any other kind of electronic communication devices.
- Other delegation members (gymnasts, coaches, medical staff) are prohibited from using cellular phones and any other kind of electronic communication devices. However, gymnasts are allowed to listen to music (with earphones and a sound level which is not observable by surrounding persons). It is also allowed to other delegation members to take photos (but no videos), without flash and not interrupting the running of the competition.

If these rules are violated, the persons concerned will receive a verbal warning.

If this behaviour is repeated after the written warning is issued, those persons concerned will be excluded for the rest of the competition.

It is the responsibility of the Superior Jury to decide these disciplinary measures.

Appeals against these decisions must be submitted to the Jury of Appeal, whose decision is final.

2.6 Medal ceremonies

The medal ceremonies will take place according to the schedule and will be organised as follows:

- o Qualifying Competition Juniors: All-Around & Team: Gold, Silver and Bronze medallists on the podium
- o Qualifying Competition Seniors: All-Around: Gold, Silver and Bronze medallists on the podium
- o Team Final Seniors: Gold, Silver and Bronze medallists on the podium
- o Apparatus Finals Juniors/Seniors: Gold, Silver and Bronze medallists on the podium

According to the FIG / TR, the gymnasts are requested to wear the national **tracksuit** during the medal ceremonies.

The participation of the medal winners in the medal ceremonies is compulsory. Gymnasts or teams that are absent for unjustified reasons will be disqualified.

Please note: to ensure the presence of all medal winners for the medal ceremonies for the Senior All-Around decision, we kindly ask the **Top 3 athletes** to stay in the **delegation seating and on-hold for the LOC from subdivision 3 on.**

2.7 Apparatus supplier

The apparatus supplier for this European Championships is Spieth.

Additional landing mats for all apparatus will be provided by the apparatus supplier in the warm up halls and for podium training. In addition, the federations are allowed to bring small protection mats /pads / coverings only. These mats / pads / coverings (e.g. carpet mats, beam protection pad) must not be thicker than 5cm and not bigger than 1.50m x 1m. These mats / pads / coverings can be used during (podium) training and warm up, but not for the touch warm up.

2.8 Scoring and distribution of results

After each competition, the results will be provided on Internet on the following website:

In addition, it will be sent to each Head of Delegation by e-mail. At the end of all competitions, all delegations will be provided with a complete set of results including the judges' individual scores.

2.9 Competition numbers (Bib)

Two (2) sets of competition numbers will be provided to the Head of Delegation by the LOC at accreditation. The numbers must be firmly attached to the competition attire throughout the entire competition.

2.10 Written exercises

NF are more than welcome to submit their gymnasts' exercises in symbol notation. If you wish to do this, we kindly ask that you email these to Mrs. Anca Mihailescu-Grigoras agrigoras@romgym.ro, the President of the Superior Jury, no later than 24 hours before the commencement of Podium Training.

2.11 New elements

New elements should be submitted by e-mail to Mrs. Anca Mihailescu-Grigoras agrigoras@romgym.ro, the President of the Superior Jury, **AS SOON AS POSSIBLE** but no later than 24 hours before the start of podium training. A technical drawing and a video must be attached to the e-mail (see FIG NL No. 42).

2.12 Anti-doping control

Any doping is prohibited. An anti-doping control can be requested at any time. Anti-doping controls will be as per Anti-Doping Control Regulations of FIG and WADA.

3. THE JURIES

3.1 Jury of Appeal

The Jury of Appeal is composed of two members of the European Gymnastics Executive Committee (one of them acting as President) and a member of the LOC who was not involved in the decision of the Superior Jury and the judging process on the concerned apparatus.

3.2 Superior Jury

3.3 Apparatus Jury

The WTC reserves the right to adapt if necessary, the composition of the judge's panels according to the situation.

All registered judges must hold a valid FIG judges brevet (15th Cycle). To be allowed to judge, the judges must have taken part in the judges' instruction, in the drawing of lots and in the briefings preceding the competition. In cases where there is an insufficient number of judges from the participating national federations, the European Gymnastics / WTC will decide the process for designating the necessary number of judges.

If a NF has a judge selected in the position of D2 on an Apparatus, they will as a result not be included in the E-Jury draw. If needed, judges registered for the Senior competition will be used also for the Junior competition and vice versa.

3.3.1 D-Jury

The D1 Judges were nominated by the European Gymnastics TC.

3.3.2 E-Jury

The E-judges will be decided by the drawing of lots on site.

The E-Jury will consist of SEVEN (7) E-Judges. The Final E-score will be determined from the average of the 3 middle scores.

All entered judges must be available until the drawing of lots for the last competition of the respective European Championships. Exceptions will be managed by Mrs. Anca Mihailescu-Grigoras, the President of the European Gymnastics WTC.

For AF Juniors & Seniors, a Federation whose gymnast has qualified for an Apparatus Final (including 1st & 2nd Reserve) will as a result, not have their judge included in the Judges Draw for the concerned Apparatus.

Cat 4 judges, if present, are only allowed to judge line and time.

As a reminder and according to the European Gymnastics / TR, the function of a judge cannot be combined with any other function.

E-judges may only attend training sessions at which their team is in attendance.

D-jury (D1- and D2-Judges) may attend all training sessions.

3.4 Judges' instruction and drawing of lots

According to the European Gymnastics / TR, the presence of the judges at the judges' instruction is mandatory. If a Judge does not arrive on and time and as a result misses the Judges Instruction, she / he will be excluded from judging.

The judges' instruction will be held in person and in English. In the event the Judges instruction is switched to an Online instruction, judges should ensure they bring their Tablet or Laptop to the championships as a back-up.

The judges' oath will be carried out at the end of the judges' instruction by one of the host Federation's judges.

3.5 Inquiries of the score

European Gymnastics applies the TR / FIG, Article 8.4.

The detailed procedure is laid down in the Technical Regulations of the FIG. Referring to European Championships organised for Juniors and Seniors, the complaints are distinct for each age group (i.e. the ECh WAG Seniors is distinct from the ECh WAG Juniors).

If the inquiry is refused, the amount will be invoiced by European Gymnastics (in Euro, not in USD) at a later date and must be paid within one month.

4.2 Orientation Meeting

The Orientation Meeting will be held on **Tuesday, 9th August 2022** at **09:00** am in the Judges Meeting Room located in the Olympiahalle. The presence of the participating National Federations at the Orientation meeting is mandatory. A maximum of 3 members per delegation, including the Head of Delegation is permitted. Unjustified failure to attend will result in a sanction against the federation of Euro €1,000.

4.3 Training information

Two sessions of training will be provided to the participating federations. European Gymnastics will endeavour to ensure there is a minimum time of 3.5 hours between the two daily training sessions for a Team/Mixed Group. A detailed program of the training will be provided to the participating NF after the drawing of lots. The delegations are obliged to respect the training schedules.

Training upon request will be possible on Monday, 8th August from 13:30 PM to 20:00 (Olympiahalle). Please complete Appendix 3 and submit the request to the LOC no later than 5 days before the Official Arrival date of Delegations per the Work Plan.

4.4 Official Podium Training

A detailed program of the official podium training will be provided to the participating NF. The presence of the D-judges is mandatory.

The presence of E-judges at the official podium training is not mandatory, however, the WTC would strongly encourage all E-Judges to be present.

4.5 Lightning

For the Senior Apparatus Finals there will be a special lightning for the respective apparatus. Therefore, an additional podium training will be offered after the Seniors Team Final on Saturday.

4.6 Accreditation

Accreditation passes will be given to the Head of Delegation for all members of a Federation (with the exception of Judges). The accreditation for judges will be given to each judge upon arrival in the official Judges hotel. The accreditation office will be located at the Delegation Information Desk in the Olympiahalle. At accreditation, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative must provide the LOC with the following:

- The passport of the gymnasts and judges
- The licences of gymnasts, judges, coaches and medical staff
- The medical insurance covering Covid19 for all delegation members (if not sent by email);
- Proof of the fulfilment of all financial obligations to the LOC (accommodation, meals)
- Floor music and “Appendix 10 – Confirmation of correctness of the WAG Floor Music”, if not sent to the LOC previously
 - Hand in one set of back-up USB key of their gymnasts’ floor exercise music, including for each USB key the name of the NF and the 3 capital letters used by FIG for the country code, the name of the gymnast, the name of the composer and of the title of the music and the exact length of the music. These back-up audio USB key must be brought for safety reasons, and will be returned at the closing banquet
 - An additional audio USB key has to be brought for the training sessions.

4.8 Meals

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be offered at the hotels. The mealtimes at the hotel are aligned with the athletes' competition schedule.

During the booking process the teams and judges can book their preferred meal option such as breakfast, half board and full board for their stay.

Note – Lunch will be provided at the venue for **ALL Judges** (D&E / Junior & Senior) on the days of Podium Training. On day of Qualification Competition (D&E Junior & / Senior) and on the day of Apparatus Finals (Junior & Senior) all "active Judges" (D&E) will receive lunch at the venue.

Farewell Banquet

The Farewell Banquet for WAG delegations will take place on **Sunday, 14th August 2022** after the last competition. Accredited Delegation members (with the exception of E- and R- media), who stay at one of the official hotels and book their accommodation through the LOC, will receive a free ticket for the Farewell Banquet. All other persons wishing to attend the Banquet will be entitled to do so, provided that a request is sent by email to the LOC at gymnastics@munich2022.com. This request should be sent no later than **4th July 2022** and should detail the number of tickets required. The cost per ticket per person is €50.

4.9 Transportation

International Transportation

The invited participating Federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members. The European Gymnastics and the LOC strongly recommend that each Federation takes out cancellation insurance for their international transportation.

The official arrival airport is Munich Airport (MUC).

All accredited teams and judges who have booked an official hotel through the Munich 2022 LOC will be provided with transfers from and to Munich Airport (MUC) or Munich Main Station. The deadline for submission of travel details is **10th July 2022** and must be done via the Munich 2022 EMS.

Local Transportation

All accredited teams and judges who have booked an official hotel through the Munich 2022 LOC **and** uploaded their arrival and departure information onto the Munich 2022 EMS by **10th July 2022**, will be provided with shuttles between the official hotels and Olympiahalle.

There will be no transport between the drop off point at Olympiahalle to / from the training venues for many reasons including, sustainability and the close proximity (maximum 10-minute walk) between the training venues and the competition venue (Olympiahalle). Please note that back-up vehicles will be made available in special situations e.g., if it is raining.

The shuttle buses will align with the training and competition scheduling.

Should any member of your Federation have accessibility requirements, please detail these under "special requests" when booking in the Munich 2022 EMS and the LOC will be in contact to discuss arrangements.

NFs who do not stay at one of the official hotels and do not upload arrival and departure information onto the Munich 2022 EMS will not be entitled to arrival and departure transfers.

4.10 Delegation boxes

Delegation Mail Boxes will be set up at the Delegation Information Desk (DID) located in the Olympiahalle. All information regarding competition, warm-up, training, as well as European Gymnastics and LOC correspondence, will be distributed via the delegation mailboxes and if possible (available as electronic file) sent by e-mail to the Heads of Delegations.

A special "Mail Box" authority card will be issued to each Head of Delegation. This card must be shown by the Head of Delegation or their designated representative when collecting all information and results from their Delegation Mail Box. The delegation member designated to collect the information from the Delegation Mail Box will be required to sign for information collected.

Physiotherapy

Rooms for physiotherapy will be provided between August 09 and August 14. The LOC will also offer physiotherapists who can be booked free of charge (subject to availability). A list will be displayed in front of the Medical Centre for booking rooms and LOC physiotherapists.

Study EC2022

The Study is about Injuries and Illnesses while and just before a multisport event. In context of the European Championships the study team will collect anonymous data about injuries and illnesses during training, warm-up and competition.

Therefore, a study team will be present at the medical centre of all official venues and will document the injuries and illnesses. The aim of the study is to provide better care for athletes during multisport events. It is important to ensure better planning for athletes and organizers with a scientific foundation.

4.12 Photo Session

Each athlete's photo in national tracksuit shall be taken after podium training. These photos will be used by the Scoring company to display on the screens during the events. For this purpose, the athletes are requested to follow the dedicated volunteers to have their pictures taken.

4.13 Research Project

During the competitions the "Institut für Angewandte Trainingswissenschaften" (IAT, Germany) will collect additional data for research purposes on the following apparatuses: Vault and Uneven Bars.

4.14 Ticketing Information

Athletes' Tickets

In the spirit of the multi-sport event, accredited athletes will have the opportunity to attend events of all nine sports free of charge. Please note that the number of available seats depends on the capacity and occupancy of the venues.

Reservations are generally not possible, and access will be granted onsite and is subject to availability. In general, no tickets will be issued. On site, the athlete can enter the venue through a specially assigned entrance (usually located at the main entrance). Admission will be granted upon presentation of a valid EC2022 accreditation.

There is no fixed entitlement to a seat. As soon as the ticket holder claims her or his seat, the athlete must release the seat and find an alternative available seat. In most venues there will be a designated area for athletes.

The current sales status can be viewed in the European Championships 2022 webshop. By clicking on the corresponding session, the sales status can be seen. In general, a distinction is made between the following levels of utilization:

Available (High probability of access to the respective event)

Limited Availability (The probability of access to the event is limited and cannot be guaranteed on site)

Not available (access to the respective event is not possible)

The sales booth is flexible and can change at short notice, therefore access is not guaranteed.

To allow other athletes to access the venue, it is important to use the exclusive entrance again when exiting the venue. This will ensure that the ticketing volunteer frees up a space in the system and another athlete has the opportunity to visit the event.

Spectators' Tickets

As a multi-sport event, European Championships Munich 2022 hosts nine different sports. In addition to the Artistic Gymnastics competitions, there is numerous other sports spectators can enjoy and buy tickets for. Some sports are even free of charge.
