8. QUALIFICATIONS

There is no qualification if less than 11 competitors (units) in categories (IW, IM, MP, TR, GR, DA).

9. FINALS

• Age Group, Junior and Senior:

Each final (IW, IM, MP, TR, GR): maximum of eleven (11) competitors: 8 best foreigncompetitors (max. 2 per nation) + 3 Czech competitors (maximum).

11. TRAINING AND COMPETITION AREAS

Warm up area is situated in a **tent outside of the competition hall**. It will be used for a <u>first 20 minutes of a warm-up before the gymnasts enter the training area in the sports hall for the rest 40 minutes before their podium time **during Saturday and Sunday competition**. The warm-up area will be used for a Friday training session according to a schedule. **During Friday competition only the training area in the sports hall will be available**. Training areas as well as the competition podium are situated in a big multifunctional stage on the ground floor and are divided into several parts, marked 7x7m and 10x10m. The competition stage is equipped with the official aerobic floor and is divided from the training areas by the background. Please, note that there will be no music in training area as it could disturb the competition. The Podium trainings will be organized according to the schedule **(App 1)**. There will be 1 training sessions for all Junior and Senior categories in the warm up area on Friday and one additional training on Saturday morning before competition for a Sunday competitors Jun and Sen cat. on a request.</u>



Training session - Friday 21st of April for the athletes who are competing in the Junior and Senior category: time per routine 1min 30 s.

Delegations are requested to fill in the respective forms for the Order of the training (**App 2**) and send them to kocova@gymfed.cz by April 17th the latest.

13. MUSIC

In order to simplify the management of the music and to limit the technical problems the federations are asked to submit the music in MP3 format ONLINE http://admin.gvmaerobic.com

Each music file will have to contain the following information:

- The name of the nation (official abbreviation of the country);
 - The first and last name of the competitor/s;
 - The category (IM, IW, MP, TR, GR, AS, AD);
 - The Junior or Senior

Delegation members are requested to keep in their possession a USB key of their music for their podium training sessions and in case of a technical problems.

14. OPENING CEREMONY

The official opening ceremony will take place on **Saturday**, **22**nd **of April from 09:10 before the beginning of the Qualifications**. Further information will be given during the Orientation Meeting.

15. AWARD CEREMONIES

The ceremonies will take place in the competition venue according to the competition schedule. For all award ceremonies gymnasts must wear their national tracksuits. Further information will be given during the Orientation Meeting.

16. INSURANCE AND MEDICAL SERVICES

The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.

The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.

The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance. During the Trainings and Competitions the LOC will provide medical services. Appointed person will be available during those times.
