5. TRANSPORTATION AND VISAS

Arrivals/Departures

Airport transfers to and from official hotels booked through the LOC will be organised by the LOC based on flight details for all participants.

Ground transportation between the official hotels and the venue will be provided by the LOC.

The schedules will be available at the hotel's hospitality desk and at the venue. Ground transportation will be organised only between official hotels and the venue.

6. ACCREDITATIONS

Access to the area Field of Play dedicated to Parkour will be given only to authorized persons (accreditation).

The accreditation is personal, non transferable and compulsory to control access to training, competition venue, functions and official transport. It identifies individuals participating in the Parkour World Cup and ensures controlled access to each area. All participants and officials are required at all times, to wear Accreditation Cards and respect those personnel responsible for monitoring entry.

Accreditation will take place the **8 September 2022** at the National Palace of Culture.

Heads of Delegations are requested to bring:

- Passports of all members of the delegation
- Insurances of all members of the delegation
- Proof for full payment of the costs due to the LOC
- Transport – Departure

The FIG Accreditation Rules will be strictly applied, notably as far as the number of accreditations per federations is concerned. Any additional person is considered as a spectator. Accreditations will not be delivered unless all financial and insurance obligations have been met.

Copies of the delegation member's valid passport will be made by the OC. Please refer to the FIG license rules for further information.

In case of lost or stolen accreditation, the Organising Committee must be informed immediately to block the accreditation. Lost or stolen accreditations may be replaced at the charge of the card holder (€ 50).

The FIG Accreditation rules have to be strictly respected. This accreditation may not be transferred during an event.

7. MEETINGS AND OTHER EVENTS

Orientation Meeting

The Orientation Meeting held in English will take place **Thursday 08 September at 18:30**. The drawing of lots for the starting order will take place at the end of the Orientation meeting.

Important and detailed information concerning the organisation will be provided by the FIG.

Participation is compulsory for athletes or heads of delegation and judges.

Judges' Instructions, Briefings.

All the judges are required to take part in this instruction and in all subsequent briefings. Judges who do not participate will not be authorised to judge.

8. INSURANCE

The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.

The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.

Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. If the note has not been sent in advance (which is strongly recommended), the LOC will verify the insurance coverage upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy).

The insurance must be valid at least starting from the arrival day of the delegation and must last for the delegations' entire stay.

10. MEALS

Breakfast and dinner for athletes and team officials will be provided at the hotel

Delegations that book their accommodation through the LOC have accommodation, breakfast and dinner in their package.

Lunch tickets can be purchased through the LOC.

Lunch price: 25 EUR per person

Delegations that book their accommodation through the LOC are invited free of charge to the Final Banquet.

Delegations having not booked their accommodation through the LOC may purchase tickets at the price of 30 euros per person.

The tickets for the Final Banquet will be available for purchase at the LOC office and must be paid to the LOC **during the accreditation**.

the Banquet will start at **8 pm on 11 September** at the restaurant near the venue. A shuttles bus from the hotels to the restaurant and then back will be available.

11. COMPETITION

Competitions will be conducted in accordance with the 2022 FIG Technical Regulations including Section 7 for PK, the current PK COP and other technical directives of the FIG.

The awards ceremonies will be held immediately after the finals. The athletes are requested to attend.

14. MEDICAL SERVICES

The medical service is provided by the Local Organizing Committee according to the FIG Rules "MEDICAL ORGANISATION OF THE FIG COMPETITIONS".

15. ANTI DOPING CONTROL AND THERAPEUTIC USE EXPEMPTIONS

The Local Organizing Committee is in charge of doping controls. This doping control can take place in any moment between the arrival of the athlete and his departure.
