ACCREDITATION	All members will receive the accreditation card after arrival.				
COMPETITION FORMAT	<p>The competition proceeds in 3 rounds:</p> <p>The first round - <u>qualification</u>: 12 mixed pairs take part, every gymnast performs on two pieces of apparatus.</p> <p>The second round – <u>semi-finals</u>: 6 best-ranked mixed pairs pass to the second round. In case of a tie for 6th place, all the mixed pairs for 6th place will participate in the second round. The starting order of the mixed pairs will be according to the results of the first round: the mixed pairs on the 6th place shall start. In the semi-finals the gymnasts perform on one piece of apparatus which must be different from first round. The results of the first round are not carried forward to the second round - start from zero.</p> <p>The third round - <u>finals</u>: 4 best ranked mixed pairs in the semi-finals pass to this final round. In case of a tie for 4th place the mixed pair with the better result in the qualification round will participate in the 3rd round. If there is also a tie, the mixed pair with the higher number of highest scores will participate in the 3rd round. The starting order will be determined by drawing of lots. In the final the female and male gymnasts perform on any of the pieces of apparatus (they can repeat any of already used piece except apparatus from the second round). The results of the previous rounds are not carried forward to the 3rd round - start from zero. The Grand Prix winner is the mixed pair with the highest sum of scores in the third round.</p>

VISA	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Czech Republic. The Local Organizing Committee (LOC) will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before September 21st, 2023 to the LOC.</p> <p>The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p>				
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. COVID 19 MEASURES	The LOC should follow local guidelines in management of COVID-19. The LOC must facilitate COVID-19 testing for delegations when it is required to have a negative test for return to their country.										
SAFEGUARDING	From the official event day of arrival until the official day of departure, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the possibility to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment and abuse of any type or if they are worried and do not feel comfortable. The information regarding the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be communicated upon arrival of the delegations on site. In addition, posters of the "10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics", the FIG campaign to raise awareness about youth protection in Gymnastics, will have to be displayed in several locations, including training and warm-up halls and public zones.
