<b>Registration procedure</b>	<p>The registration of participants and judges is the sole responsibility of the clubs and is done on a club-by-club basis via the internet registration tool GymNet at <a href="http://www.dtb-gymnet.de">www.dtb-gymnet.de</a>. The registration of participants via the DTB-GymNet will only be accepted and processed if the required judges are registered at the same time and correctly.</p> <p>The instructions for the correct registration of judges in GymNet can be found at the following link: <a href="https://www.btv-turnen.de/sport/geraeturnen/hinweise-kari-meldung-gymnet.pdf">https://www.btv-turnen.de/sport/geraeturnen/hinweise-kari-meldung-gymnet.pdf</a></p> <p>When registering, the person responsible for registration must confirm in GymNet that the club has received the extended certificate of good conduct and a signed copy of the <a href="#">code of honor</a> for all registered coaches and judges.</p>
<b>Application fee</b>	<p><b>95,00 €</b> for each registered team.</p> <p>The registration fee is due with the registration and will not be refunded in case of non-participation.</p> <p>The fee will be collected by direct debit from the account specified in DTB-GymNet. The billing address can be issued individually to the club name or address in DTB-GymNet under "Allgemeine Angaben".</p> <p><b>The BTV will not change the billing address at a later date!</b></p> <p>Cancellations are only possible free of charge by deleting the entry until the entry deadline.</p>
<b>Deadline</b>	<p><b><u>18.03.2024</u> – GymNet is open until 23:59.</b></p> <p>There is no late registration deadline. Once the registration portal is closed, registration is no longer possible.</p>

**Tumbling:**

NO bonus for Nachwuchs- & Schülerklasse. There will be no deduction from E1-Judge for missing back or front handsprings. All red-labeled classes get a bonus of 0,3 points for every element with rotation (such as back handsprings, front handsprings, or flips – cartwheels and roundoffs don't), which will be added to the D-score on the scoresheet.

**Trampet:**

All red-labeled classes get a bonus of 0.3 points for every element with rotation, which will be added to the D-score on the scoresheet.

**Music**

A link will be sent to the mail address stored in GymNet. Please upload the music in mp3 format until **April 15, 2024** named the following way:  
**club + no.\_apparatus; e.g. SV Lohhof 1\_Tumbling.mp3**

**Important information**

Competitions will only be held if at least three participants per competition or age group are registered. If there are fewer than three entries by the deadline, the competition will, if possible, be combined with the next higher competition or age group and scored together. Otherwise, the competition will be canceled. The participants registered for the competition will be informed about the procedure immediately after the deadline.

**Eligibility**

German clubs (members of DTB) and guest teams from abroad are eligible to compete. Participants from Germany must have a valid digital DTB start pass with the registered start right "TeamGym" for the registering club.

In case of false entries in the TURNPORTAL, the competition management can exclude a gymnast from the competition (see BTV rules of conduct and procedures of competitions and DTB regulations).

According to the valid DTB competition and passport regulations, all participants must be able to identify themselves additionally by an official document, e.g. (children's) passport, (children's) identity card, or adequate identity card with photo.

Copies of ID cards will be accepted if they are clearly legible, and the person

shown is clearly recognizable on the passport photo.

It is up to the competition management to exclude the gymnast from the competition even if he/she cannot identify him/herself or if the copy of the official document is of such poor quality that the person cannot be clearly identified as the registered gymnast on the copy of the ID.

Each club will provide **at least two judges** for the entire competition day, **at least one of them with a valid license**. If the required judges are not provided, participation is excluded.

The registered judges will be deployed for the entire duration of the competition.

The registered judges will be used for the entire duration of the competition. If a club does not start due to cancellations after the closing date, the obligation to provide the required judges remains.


