8. QUALIFICATIONS

Age Group, Junior and Senior:

There is no qualification if less than 9 competitors (units) in category (IW, IM, MP, TR, GR, DA).

9. FINALS

Each final (IW, IM, MP, TR, GR): maximum of eleven (11) competitors: **8 best foreign** competitors (max. 2 per nation) + 3 Czech competitors (maximum).

10. RULES AND REGULATIONS

11. TRAINING AND COMPETITION AREAS

 Training areas as well as the competition podium are situated in a big multifunctional stage on the ground floor and marked 10x10m. The competition stage is equipped with the official aerobic floor and is divided from the training areas with a background. Please, note that there will be no music in training area as it could disturb the competition. The Podium training will be organized according to the schedule (App 1). Training session 1 - Thursday 24th of April for all the athletes, time per routine 1min 30 s.

Nations are requested to fill in the respective forms for the Order of the training (**App 2**) and send it to <u>kocova@gymfed.cz</u> by April 18th the latest.

There will be one additional training on Saturday morning before competition for a Sunday competitors Jun and Sen cat. on a request (App 3). (*the categories having only finals on Sunday*).

During Thursdays and Fridays competiton there will be a small gym under the Hotel Řepy section available for anyone not competing that day. Accesibe by the tunnel from -1 floor where dressing rooms are in the Sports Hall. During Saturday and Sunday is this gym reserved for competitions as a warm up area.

Please respect the time table and use the training and warm up area only as stated above in order to keep as much space as possible for those ready to compete.

13. MUSIC

In order to simplify the management of the music and to limit the technical problems the federations are asked to submit the music in MP3 format ONLINE http://admin.gvmaerobic.com

Each music file will have to contain the following information:

- The name of the nation (official abbreviation of the country);
- The first and last name of the competitor/s;
- The category (IM, IW, MP, TR, GR, AS, AD);
- The Junior or Senior

Delegation members are requested to keep in their possession a USB key of their music for their podium training sessions and in case of a technical problems.

14. OPENING CEREMONY

The official opening ceremony will take place on **Friday**, **25th of April at 13:20 before the beginning of the Qualifications**.

15. AWARD CEREMONIES

The ceremonies will take place in the competition venue according to the competition schedule. For all award ceremonies gymnasts must wear their national tracksuits.

16. INSURANCE AND MEDICAL SERVICES

The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.

The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.

The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance. During the Trainings and Competitions the LOC will provide medical services. Appointed person will be available during those times.

20. DISTRIBUTION OF INFORMATION, RESULTS, SCHEDULES

Each Nation is responsible to have the Work Plan in advance. Only changes to it and additional/ new schedules will be handed with one set of updated Starting tables for Qualifications (updatesafter the accreditation) will be given to each Nation at the end of the Orientation meeting. In addition, it will be sent to all by e-mail to the e-mail address given during the accreditation. The same will be done with the Starting tables for the Finals, Friday evening by e-mail and later. The complete set of Results will be sent to each participating Federation by e-mail, after the competition is over.
