PARTICIPANTS

The “SCALABISCUP” is an international event, open to all clubs affiliated in the respective Federations as well as Representatives of National Federations, District or Regional Associations. The participating gymnast should have valid insurance, being the same of the gymnast’s responsibility. The organizers will not be held responsible for any accidents.



RULES

The rules of the “SCALABISCUP” competition are the rules defined in the FIG Technical Regulation and the FIG Code of Points 2025-28 with the exceptions foreseen in the present regulation.

Each gymnast can only participate in one group in each of the classes.

FINALS

TRA – U12, U14, U21

The 8 (eight) best qualified gymnasts at the end of qualifying rounds in the different classes will participate in the final.

If only 8 or less gymnasts take part on the qualifying rounds, the results of the final will be added to the qualifications to obtain the result.

DMT – U12, U14, U21

TUM – U12, U14

The 8 (eight) best qualified gymnasts at the end of qualifying rounds in the different classes will participate in the final 1.

The 4 (four) best qualified gymnasts in Final 1 will participate in final 2.

If only 8 or less gymnasts take part on the qualifying rounds, the results of the final will be added to the qualifications to obtain the result.

TRA, DMT & TUM – JUNIOR & SENIOR

FIG rules for qualifying for semi-finals, if applicable, and for finalists.

TIE-BREAK

Tie-break rules defined in FIG Code of Points 2025-28 will apply.

PRIZES

The 1ST, 2ND and 3RD classified in each individual class will receive a medal.

All the competitors will receive a Participation Certificate.

The teams classified in 1ST, 2ND and 3RD places in the team competition will receive a trophy.



TEAM RESULTS

The top 3 final results, from elements of the same team, in Individual Competition obtained at Qualifying round will be added together to get a total score and determine the team classification.

There are no team final

PRIZE MONEY

Trampoline Individual, Double-mini Trampoline and Tumbling

SENIOR Category - Only

Due to the possible restrictions on the number of participants, monetary awards may also undergo adaptations, namely:

- Up to 200 participants - no monetary prize will be awarded.
- 201 to 400 participants - 50% of the amount provided for in the regulation will be delivered.
- If there will be 16 gymnasts, or less, starting the Senior competition, it will be awarded 50% of the predicted value



JUDGES

It is compulsory that the participating Delegations include in their delegation at least one (1) judge with FIG. If the delegation does not include any Open or Junior gymnast, the organization committee may accept national judges.

The number of judges to be presented by the delegation is determined by the **total number of entries** in all apparatus:

- 3 to 12 entries = 1 judge
- 13 to 22 entries = 2 judges
- 23 to 35 entries = 3 judges
- 36 or more entries = 4 judges

The Clubs, Associations or Federations that do not oblige by the established rules relating to the disposability of judges will be penalized with the payment of **300 Euros (Three Hundred Euros)** for each missing judge. The non-payment of the penalization will imply the non-participation in the event of the respective competitors. All the judges indicated by the respective Clubs, Associations and Federations to the organization will have to be present at the respective judges meetings.

Note: Transport, accommodation and meals of each delegation judges are the responsibility of the respective delegation.



ENTRIES

ENTRIES

Entries will be considered on a first come first served basis (email or fax).

Declaration of interest: until 1st March 2026

Definitive Entries: until 1st May 2026

Definitive entries will only be accepted with payment of:

- 100% of the amount of the entries (amount not refunded if event occur as planed);
- 50% of the amount of the accommodation. The remaining 50% of the accommodation costs must be paid by 1st of June or to be paid upon Accreditation in Cash (euros).
- Visa request form.

Nominal Entries: until 1ST of June 2026

Final documentation and payments: until 1st of June of 2026:

- Transportation form;
- Meals and final party form;
- Payment of 100% of transportation, meals and final party;
- Payment of the remaining 50% of the accommodation. Or to be paid upon accreditation in Cash (euros), in accord with organization;
- Payment of the penalty fees for missing judges (this value will be returned if, until 15th of June, the missing judges are presented)

ENTRY FEE

€27 (twenty-seven euros) per gymnast in Individual Trampoline, or Double-mini Trampoline or Tumbling
€40 (forty euros) per gymnast that apply for two specialties

€55 (fifty five euros) per gymnast that participate at all apparatus

NOTE: Definitive entries placed from 2nd of May and after, will be charged with an extra 10%

The entries for the Team Competition are free of charge

CLOSING CEREMONY

The Closing Ceremony (Farewell party) will take place on Saturday, 11th of July, and dinner is included.

ACCOMMODATION, MEALS AND TRANSPORTATION

The Organizers will arrange, at a determined fee, accommodation and meals from the 6th to 13th of July.

If desirable, the Organization can manage special packs according to Delegations needs.

There will be special packs for those who would desire to stay training in Santarém after SCALABISCUP.

- If the event is confirmed, cancellation of accommodation between 1st of May and 1st of June 2026, will be subject to a charge of 50% per person.
- Cancellation of accommodation after 1st of June is not refundable.
