The number of **National Development** and **Youth** participants by nation, category and age group **is not limited**.

All gymnasts of Youths, Juniors and Seniors must have a valid FIG license until the end of the event!

The LOC will be responsible for checking the validity of all **Juniors** and **Seniors** gymnasts Licenses. No Juniors and Seniors gymnasts will be accepted without a valid FIG License until the end of the event.

EVENT FORMAT	<p>The International Open Competition consists of qualifications and finals. There will be qualifications only for the categories and age groups with more than 9 participants. In case of a tie in any place, the tie-breaking rules are as set by FIG.</p> <p>Participation in the finals: The top eight units per category and age group will qualify for the Finals (maximum of 2 per Category and nation).</p> <p>In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules are the FIG World Championships Rules.</p> <p>The LOC may cancel the competition in the respective category if at the time of the definitive entry, there are less than 3 countries or regions registered in a category. In case of such a cancellation, the LOC must reimburse, in full, the entry fee and payments made for accommodation. Should flights have to be canceled due to the above, the risk is at the charge of the participating member Federation.</p>
JUDGES AND JURIES	<p>The number of Juries (judges' panels) may be decided by the Organizing Member Federation depending on the number of participating competitors and judges.</p> <p>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet in the discipline concerned. The Juries are set up by a draw and directed by the Technical Delegate from the judges present at the event. Priority will be given to the judges of the highest category. If, on the day of the competition, there are no sufficient numbers of judges in the requested categories, the Technical Delegate may take whatever action needed to secure the running of the event. Each participating federation must provide minimum one judge Cat. 1, 2, 3 or 4 with current valid brevet. Failure to do so, will result in a fine of CHF 2'000.- to be paid to the LOC until the Definitive Registration date (April 27,2026).</p>
DRAWING OF LOTS	<p>The drawing of lots will take place at the LOC office 2weeks after the closing date of Nominative Registration.</p>
PRIZE MONEY	<p>No prize money will be paid to the senior/Junior/Youth/ND winners. A medal will be presented to the top 3 gymnasts/units for each category.</p>

REGISTRATION DEADLINES	<p>The Definitive and Nominative Registration Forms should be sent by the LOC within the deadlines mentioned below. All the rates are per person, per night including BF, all taxes and service charges. Lunch and Dinner are NOT included.</p> <p>The prices charged for the hotel rooms will not exceed the usual hotel rates. FINAL BANQUET	<p>The LOC will organize a Final banquet on June 29, 2026. It will take place in the evening, after the Finals. The price is USD 29 per person.</p> <p>The Farewell party tickets should be requested with the Meals form and paid to the LOC not later than May 6, 2026.</p> <p>Cancellations or modifications of the Farewell party tickets/ number of people are accepted by May 22, 2026. INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members (see exception herein below). The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by April 22, 2026.</p>
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>During the competition, shuttle bus services between the hotel and the venue are free of charge.</p> <p>Arrival and departure –Nanchang: The LOC may provide transportation to all delegation members, who have booked their accommodation through the LOC, from and to KHN airport, Nanchang railway station or Nanchang West railway station or Nanchang East railway station to the official hotel in Nanchang and back on the official arrival (June 25 ,2026) and departure days (June 30, 2026).</p> <p>Transportation will be provided only on the official arrival (June 25) and departure (June 30) dates at the prices listed in the table below.</p>

This transportation should be requested with the official Travel form sent to the OC and LOC and should be paid to the LOC not later than **May 6, 2026**. The transportation costs cannot be reimbursed.

For those delegations or member of delegations that do not arrive or depart on the official day, upon request, the LOC may arrange additional transportation. The cost for it depends on the number of people, the date and time. Please, send your request to the LOC as soon as possible but not later than **May 6, 2026** in order to be able to arrange transportation and inform you about the price.

VISA

Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Chinese Embassy or Consulate in your country/region if a visa is required for your travel to **April 22, 2026**. The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before **April 22, 2026** to the LOC. The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.

INSURANCE

The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.

The LOC will verify the insurance coverage upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance coverage must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance coverage at the Federations own charge as follows: **USD 22 per person/day, USD 32 per person/ 6 days**.

OFFICIAL HOSPITAL	When an accident occurs, the LOC makes a phone to an “emergency medical-care center” and ask which hospital can accept the injured person depending on the gravity and the incident occurred. Once the emergency medical-care center advised the LOC of the proper hospital able to treat the injured person, the ambulance will direct him/her to this center for proper medical care.
