Final Timetable:

The final timetable will be published after the registration deadline. Changes to the provisional schedule are possible and likely and are explicitly accepted upon registration.

Participation Requirements:

Recognition and compliance with the General Competition Regulations of Turnsport Austria and all applicable rules of the respective sport.

Registration:

By 31 May 2026 exclusively through the respective gymnastics federation via email. (entry form)

Apparatus:

SPIETH- Women's Artistic Gymnastics apparatus set

Judges:

Each participating national federation must nominate **3 judges per registered team.**

In case a federation is not able to fulfill the required number of judges, it must cover the travel expenses, accommodation, and per diem of the judge appointed by the organizer.

Coaches:

Each registered team may nominate an unlimited number of coaches. A maximum of two coaches per team are permitted in the Field of Play at any given time. Contrary to the provisions outlined in the Code of Points, two male coaches are also permitted to supervise the team.

Tie- Breaking:

In the case of equal final scores, an ex-aequo placement will apply (FIG tie-break rules will not be applied).



Awards:

Team and individual award ceremonies will take place after the competition.

Certificates will be provided online as downloads.

Titles:

The winning teams will receive medals. The winners of the individual rankings will receive an award.

Safeguarding Officer:

Team Composition:

Each national federation may enter one team per category.

Additional Mats:

Additionally, federations may apply to enter individual gymnasts beyond the nominated teams. Approval is subject to organizational capacity and will be decided by the competition management without possibility of appeal.

One additional landing mat (max. 10 cm height) is permitted. It may be placed in **one corner** of the floor area. After the landing, the mat may either be removed or left in place.

Uneven Bars:

An additional spotting mat is permitted for safety during flight elements.
